- Yehowah God promised to greatly increase the pain of pregnancy for the woman after her disobedience.
- To the woman he said; I shall greatly increase the pain of your pregnancy. In birth pangs you will bring forth children, and your craving will be for your husband, and he will dominate you. (Genesis 3:16)
- Joseph kept increasing the portions carried to Benjamin his favored brother.
- And he kept having portions carried from before him to them, but he would increase Benjamin's portion five times the size of the portions of all the others. So they continued banqueting and drinking with him to the full. (Genesis 43:34)
- Jacob blessed Joseph's two sons so that they would increase to a multitude in the earth.
- The angel who has been recovering me from all calamity, bless the boys. And let my name be called upon them and the name of my fathers, Abraham and Isaac. And let them increase to a multitude in the midst of the earth. (Genesis 48:16)
- The value of land sold was based upon the Jubilee year when all possessions were returned to their rightful owners.
- In proportion to the great number of years he should increase its purchase value, and in proportion to the fewness of years he should reduce its purchase value, because the number of the crops is what he is selling to you. (Leviticus 25:16)
- The tribes of Israel were to increase their land inheritances due to their numbers, so that they would each have a similar amount of land to work and live upon.
- According to the great number you should increase ones inheritance, and according to the fewness you should reduce

- ones inheritance. Each ones inheritance should be given in proportion to his registered ones. (Numbers 26:54)
- And you must apportion the land to yourselves as a possession by lot according to your families. To the populous one you should increase his inheritance, and to the sparse one you should reduce his inheritance. To where the lot will come out for him, there it will become his. By the tribes of your fathers you should provide yourselves with landed property. (Numbers 33:54)
- Moses asked Yehowah God to increase Israel a thousand times more than their forefathers.
- May Yehowah the God of your forefathers increase you a thousand times as many as you are, and may he bless you just as he has promised you. (Deuteronomy 1:11)
- And your herd and your flock may increase, and silver and gold may increase for you, and all that is yours may increase.

 (Deuteronomy 8:13)
- The king of Israel was told not to increase horses for himself, but to look to Yehowah God for protection from the surrounding nations.
- Only he should not increase horses for himself, nor make the people go back to Egypt in order to increase horses, whereas Yehowah has said to you, you must never go back again by this way. (Deuteronomy 17:16)
- Likewise he should not multiply or increase wives for himself, nor increase his gold and silver very much, thus trusting in these things.
- He should also not multiply wives for himself, that his heart may not turn aside, nor should he increase silver and gold for himself very much. (Deuteronomy 17:17)
- For disobedience Yehowah God promised to increase calamities upon his people Israel.
- I shall increase calamities upon them; My arrows I shall spend upon them. (Deuteronomy 32:23)
- Amnon made guiltiness increase in Israel, and did not humble himself like his father Manasseh.

- And he did not humble himself because of Yehowah the same as Manasseh his father humbled himself, for Amon was one that made guiltiness increase. (2 Chronicles 33:23)
- The king of Persia issued an order and commanded it be kept, so that harm might not increase to him.
- So be careful that there be no negligence about acting in this regard, that the harm may not increase to the injury of kings. (Ezra 4:22)
- Job asked what increase men can accomplish against Yehowah God, by their many revolts.
- If you actually sin, what do you accomplish against him? And if your revolts actually increase, what do you do to him? (Job 35:6)
- The Psalmist called for the name of Yehowah God to continue to time indefinite, and for his name to have increase, for him to be revered by his people, more and more.
- Let his name prove to be to time indefinite, before the sun let his name have increase, and by means of him let them bless themselves. Let all nations pronounce him happy. (Psalms 72:17)
- The Psalmist showed, that Yehowah God would give increase as part of his blessing to his people Israel.
- Yehowah will give increase to you, to you and to your sons. (Psalms 115:14)
- Impart knowledge to someone righteous and he will increase in learning.
- Give to a wise person and he will become still wiser. Impart knowledge to someone righteous and he will increase in learning. (Proverbs 9:9)
- The one collecting by the hand is the one that makes true increase, whereas a vain person collects empty things.
- **Valuable things resulting from vanity become fewer, but the one**

collecting by the hand is the one that makes increase. (Proverbs 13:11)

- The meek ones will certainly increase their rejoicing in Yehowah God himself.
- And the meek ones will certainly increase their rejoicing in Yehowah himself, and even the poor ones of mankind will be joyful in the Holy One of Israel himself. (Isaiah 29:19)
- Arrows are the first part of the assault on a city. They are sent over the wall from a distance before the main assault on the wall and gates begins. Likewise armies surround a city attacking from a distance and causing famine inside the walls. Jehovah's Witnesses today are without continuing spiritual food from Yehowah.
- They are unfaithful, focusing their study of God's word on times long past, and not applying it to present and future. They have books to read and study, but in the last 20 years since the Revelation Climax book was published, they have not produced any deep spiritual books, nor shown insight into God's forward moving purposes.
- Most of their seven million members have never even seen, much less studied, a deeply spiritual book, because they just don't make them anymore. Yehowah has broken their connection to his rod of truth and so there is no bread. Surely famine will result and increase upon them!
- When I send the injurious arrows of the famine upon them, which must prove to be for ruination, which arrows I shall send to bring you people to ruin, even famine I shall increase upon you people and I will break your rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended. (Ezekiel 5:16)
- Then he refers to their sharing of the sacrifices of their God, which today refers to their eating of spiritual food within Christendom. They will eat, or study the Bible, but will not get satisfied, not fully understanding it, and revealing its purpose. They will then come to disrespect their religious organizations, women, treating them as harlots, and thus they will not increase, because they have left off paying respect for Yehowah God himself.
- And they will actually eat, but will not get satisfied. They will actually treat women as harlots, but they will not increase,

because they have left off paying regard to Yehowah himself. (Hosea 4:10)

- So because of this supporting work by Paul and others, the congregations continued to be made firm in the faith, and so they were increasing from day to day.
- Therefore, indeed, the congregations continued to be made firm in the faith and to increase in number from day to day. (Acts of Apostles 16:5)
- Paul then assures those ones in Corinth, that their kind giving is in front of the eyes of Yehowah God, who sees their doing fine works in imitation of him, and since he is the one from whom all blessings flow, they need not worry, for he will thus increase the products of their righteousness, through good works in behalf of others, if they show delight and willingness in doing these fine works.
- Now he that abundantly supplies seed to the sower and bread for eating will supply and multiply the seed for you to sow and will increase the products of your righteousness. (2 Corinthians 9:10)
- Paul then expressed his wish, that the Lord may bless them to have a fine increase, through the preaching of the Good News of God's Kingdom. He wants them also to increase in love for one another, and to all others, even as he is doing.
- Moreover, may the Lord cause you to increase, yes, make you abound, in love to one another and to all, even as we also do to you. (1 Thessalonians 3:12)
