

~INFLICT (40)

[English, impose, exact, mete out, wreak, cause]

- Yehowah promised his people that if they continued in opposition to him he would **inflict** seven times more blows upon them.
- But if you keep walking in opposition to me and not wishing to listen to me, I shall then have to **inflict** seven times more blows upon you according to your sins. (**Leviticus 26:21**)
- So Jehoram the king returned to get healed at Jezreel from the wounds that the Syrians got to **inflict** upon him at Ramah when he fought Hazael the king of Syria. As for Ahaziah the son of Jehoram the king of Judah, he went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, for he was sick. (**2 Kings 8:29**)
- Later Jehoram the king returned to get healed at Jezreel from the wounds that the Syrians got to **inflict** upon him when he fought Hazael the king of Syria. Jehu now said; If your soul agrees, do not let anyone go out in escape from the city to go and make report in Jezreel. (**2 Kings 9:15**)
- Paul, as one of the anointed ones, said;
- And we are holding ourselves in readiness to **inflict** punishment for every disobedience, as soon as your own obedience has been fully carried out. (**2 Corinthians 10:6**)
- Peter counseled Christians to be obedient to worldly authorities, who stand ready to **inflict** punishment upon evildoers.
- Or to governor's as being sent by him to **inflict** punishment on evildoers but to praise doers of good. (**1 Peter 2:14**)
