## ~INHABITED (607)

[English, occupied, settled, populated, peopled, colonized, Opposite of, uninhabited]

- The Israelites ate manna in the wilderness until they came to Canaan, a land inhabited.
- And the sons of Israel ate the manna forty years, until their coming to a land inhabited. The manna was what they ate until their coming to the frontier of the land of Canaan. (Exodus 16:35)
- Just like Sodom and Gomorrah they would lay waste, never to be re-inhabited for generation after generation. Once Yehowah brings the United Nations against false religion, thus destroying it, false religion will never come back again to become a force in the world.
- It will become just like the ruins of ancient Babylon, where today no one lives, not even nomadic shepherds. The domain of false religion is to become completely devastated, like Sodom and Gomorrah and ancient Babylon, with no one passing through it forever.
- She will never be inhabited, nor will she reside for generation after generation. And there the Arab will not pitch his tent, and no shepherds will let their flocks lie down there. (Isaiah 13:20)
- Many men think that they can do as they please with God's earth, but Yehowah has a purpose of his own for our earth. He will not leave it in the custodial care of men, who seek to ruin and destroy it. (Revelation 1:18) He originally made earth as a permanent home for the human family to inhabit, and his grand purpose is what will come to be.
- For this is what Yehowah has said, the Creator of the heavens, He the true God, the Former of the earth and the Maker of it, He the One who firmly established it, who did not create it simply for nothing, who formed it even to be inhabited; I am Yehowah, and there is no one else. (Isaiah 45:18)
- Jerusalem refused to hear any counsel or to respond to the discipline of Yehowah through his prophets, and today Jehovah's Witnesses have behaved in the same indecent manner. They also

follow the same pattern of ancient Israel of rejecting discipline. If they continue in this they will become a land not inhabited.

- Be corrected, O Jerusalem, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a desolate waste, a land not inhabited. (Jeremiah 6:8)
- Men who trust in such things, other than in God, isolate themselves from others and become self-centered. The true source of blessings is the true God, Yehowah, and he is a generous outgoing God who looks after the needs of all of his creation. Such a man may find a way in life, but it will be a solitary existence, away from all of the goodness of Yehowah, that makes life truly wonderful.
- And he will certainly become like a solitary tree in the desert plain and will not see when good comes, but he must reside in parched places in the wilderness, in a salt country that is not inhabited. (Jeremiah 17:6)
- If Israel would come to do Yehowah God's will, then Jerusalem would become a city inhabited to time indefinite.
- There will also certainly enter in by the gates of this city kings with princes, sitting on the throne of David, riding in the chariot and upon horses, they and their princes, the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and this city will certainly be inhabited to time indefinite. (Jeremiah 17:25)
- The Jeremiah Yehowah God promise the king of Judah to make him desolate like a wilderness, and among the cities of Judah not one would be inhabited.
- For this is what Yehowah has said concerning the house of the king of Judah; You are as Gilead to me, the head of Lebanon.

  Assuredly I shall make you a wilderness, as for the cities, not one will be inhabited. (Jeremiah 22:6)
- The days of false religion are over. She has had a long reign, but now to time indefinite she will become desolate, uninhabited. Men will look at her present desolate condition and whistle and stare in astonishment on account of all of her plagues. She behaved indecently regarding God's anointed sons, and now her day of accounting has come.

- Because of the indignation of Yehowah she will not be inhabited, and she must become a desolate waste in her entirety. As for anyone passing along by Babylon, he will stare in astonishment and whistle on account of all her plagues. (Jeremiah 50:13)
- Jehovah's Witnesses have worshipped growth and strength of numbers and compared themselves to mighty worldly nations.
   Therefore their land, their spiritual estate, will become a desolate waste because they did not rely on Yehowah to sustain them.
- Their pride, their 100,000 inhabited city-like congregations, will be devastated by governmental bans and the sword of divine vengeance will chase them after.
- And the inhabited cities themselves will be devastated, and the land itself will become a mere desolate waste, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 12:20)
- Jehovah's Witnesses reach out into 235 lands and islands of the sea. After their world headquarters is struck the governments will turn against her and all other religions worldwide. These religious island nations that garnered support from peoples all over the world will be no more.
- They have all become strong as traveling merchants pedaling their wares all over the earth. She has filled the earth with terror, especially Christendom and the Jews, by their violence and hatreds stemming from false religious teachings.
- And they must raise up over you a dirge and say to you; How you have perished, that used to be inhabited from the seas, O praised city, who became a strong one in the sea, she and those inhabiting her, those who gave their terror to all the inhabitants of the earth! (Ezekiel 26:17)
- Jehovah's Witnesses have prided themselves on numbers and have worshipped growth rather than listen to and trust in Yehowah and so he will make them devastated. The waters of truth, that her Governing Body tried to suppress will come crashing back over her bringing about her complete ruin. Her world headquarters will be destroyed and then the water of truth will sweep back over her leaving only the bare surface of a crag. She will be made to be like cities not inhabited.

- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; When I make you a devastated city, like the cities that are actually not inhabited, when I bring up over you the watery deep, and the vast waters will have covered you. (Ezekiel 26:19)
- The Great City, modern day Tyre, will go down to the pit like other ancient cities that were destroyed long ago. She will cease to be a hub of world commerce and trading and a busy seaport. She will no longer be a world governmental center and the home of the United Nations. She will be scraped clean down to bare rock and she will cease from being inhabited. Apart from her, those left alive, a remnant, Yehowah will decorate or beautify.
- I will also bring you down with those going down into the pit to the people of long ago, and I will cause you to dwell in the lowest land, like places devastated for a long time, with those going down into the pit, in order, that you may not be inhabited, and I will put decoration in the land of those alive. (Ezekiel 26:20)
- Without the waters of truth that only Yehowah supplies the land will simply not support life. Forty years is a time of testing and discipline, and during this time she will not be inhabited. People will realize over this time that without the water of truth that belongs to Yehowah there can be no spiritual life. No manmade system can continue without it.
- There will not pass through it the foot of earthling man, nor will the foot of domestic animal pass through it, and for forty years it will not be inhabited. (Ezekiel 29:11)
- These spiritually insensitive religious nations both ancient and modern will not carry forth the blessing nor become part of the seed of promise. They will all become desolate wastes, uninhabited and no one will carry on their way of worship again because they all demonstrated a hatred or enmity for the true seed and sought their blood in the day of their distress.
- Indefinitely lasting desolate wastes are what I shall make you, and your own cities will not be inhabited, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 35:9)
- They would come back from Babylon some 70 years later, about 49,100 of them, a mere remnant but a unified people, no longer two nations but one. Then the devastated places would be re-inhabited.

That remnant did return and Yehowah blessed them and they grew into a strong people again.

- Their repurchase by Yehowah and the gathering of them back to their homeland prophetically pictured Yehowah's gathering of a repentant people after the destruction of all false religion, Babylon the Great during this time of the end.
- And I will multiply upon you humankind, the whole house of Israel, all of it, and the cities must become inhabited, and the devastated places themselves will be rebuilt. (Ezekiel 36:10)
- During the time that Yehowah will restore a repentant remnant and bring them back to their land, their spiritual estate and he will greatly multiply both the nation and their flocks. His blessings upon them will be even greater than before his disciplining of them. Look at the successive courses of the Jews, Christianity, Christendom and Jehovah's Witnesses. After each disciplining a greater blessings fell to the repentant ones. An even grander blessing is yet ahead.
- Yes, I will multiply upon you humankind and animalkind, and they will certainly multiply and become fruitful, and I shall actually cause you to be inhabited as in your former condition and I will do more good than in your initial state, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 36:11)
- Once his people develop a right heart and feel repentance over their dead works, he will prosper them and cause mankind to multiply and their cities, or congregations, to be inhabited. Even the devastated places like the temple will be rebuilt. The land will prosper under the blessing of God and a cleansed people.
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; In the day of my cleansing you from all your errors I will also cause the cities to be inhabited, and the devastated places must be rebuilt. (Ezekiel 36:33)
- A transformation of their land and of their spiritual estate would then come about. A land not cultivated for 70 years would spring to life looking to all like the Garden of Eden because of its fertility and God's blessing upon it. Cities long abandoned would be put in order and their walls repaired, re-inhabited. People would again teem in the land. Every passerby would remark at the dramatic change.

- And people will certainly say; That land yonder which was laid desolate has become like the garden of Eden, and the cities that were a waste and that were laid desolate and that were torn down are fortified, they have become inhabited. (Ezekiel 36:35)
- Yet as regards his people Judah, to time indefinite it will remain inhabited, and New Jerusalem will exist for generation after generation throughout his New Order.
- But as for Judah, to time indefinite it will be inhabited, and Jerusalem to generation after generation. (Joel 3:20)
- Then this second angel said to the first one, to run and go over to the man with the measuring rope, and there say to him; That as open rural country, Jerusalem will be inhabited, because of the multitude of men and domestic animals in the midst of her. This, showing, that in that system of things, land will not be bought and sold and measured out carefully, as it was in Zechariah's day and before then.
- Then he said to him; Run, speak to the young man over there, saying; As open rural country Jerusalem will be inhabited, because of the multitude of men and domestic animals in the midst of her. (Zechariah 2:4)
- Then Yehowah God shows them, that they should obey the words of Yehowah God, that he called out by means of his former prophets, back when their holy city of Jerusalem was still inhabited, and lying at ease, with all of her dependent towns lying all around her, and while the Negeb and the Shephelah were still inhabited.
- Should you not obey the words that Yehowah called out by means of the former prophets, while Jerusalem happened to be inhabited, and at ease, with her cities all around her, and while the Negeb and the Shephelah were inhabited? (Zechariah 7:7)
- Then other cities of the seacoast seeing this destruction would also get afraid, and as for Gaza she would also feel severe pains. Ekron also would experience these, for her looked for hope, will have to experience shame. Then a king will certainly perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon herself, the Philistines one time capitol city, will not even be inhabited.
- This prophecy of Zechariah's, recorded after Babylon's fall, pointed to future calamities. Gaza will also feel very severe pains.

History confirms the fulfillment of the foretold calamities. In the latter half of the Fourth Century B.C.E, Alexander the Great, after a fivemonth siege, took Gaza.

- Many of its inhabitants were slain, and the survivors were sold into slavery. Over 200 years later, the Jew Alexander Jannaeus, after a year's siege, completely devastated the city. [Jewish Antiquities, XIII, 364, xiii, 3] Although the Roman governor of Syria, Gabinius, ordered the rebuilding of Gaza, this was likely done on a new site. [Jewish Antiquities, XIV, 87,88, v, 3]
- Ashkelon will see and get afraid, and as for Gaza, she will also feel very severe pains, Ekron also, because her looked-for hope will have to experience shame. And a king will certainly perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon herself will not be inhabited. (Zechariah 9:5)
- Then in that day, Yehowah God will make his sheiks in Judah, his spirit anointed Christian sons, like a firepot set among the trees, and like a fiery torch touched to a row of newly cut grain. They will then devour on their right hand and on their left, all the peoples dwelling round about, and then Jerusalem, the New Jerusalem, must be inhabited in her own place, showing that the true worship of Yehowah God will then have its rightful place in this world.
- In that day I shall make the sheiks of Judah like a firepot among trees and like a fiery torch in a row of newly cut grain, and they must devour on the right hand and on the left all the peoples round about, and Jerusalem must yet be inhabited in her own place, in Jerusalem. (Zechariah 12:6)
- Then through these living waters Jerusalem will be changed to become like the Arabah, from Geba to Rimmon on the south, and she must rise and become inhabited in her place. Then a number of gates within the city are mentioned as to the extent of this change.
- The Arabah, is that part of the extraordinary depression, or rift valley, that extends toward the South from the slopes of Mount Hermon, which cradles the Sea of Galilee and the Jordan River, and then drops far below sea level to form the basin of the Dead Sea, and then continues on southward to the Gulf of `Aqaba at the Red Sea. This long, narrow, north to south valley, is often dry, and containing few cities, and is limited on each side by a long row of mountains. It varies in width from less than 0.5 to 10 miles wide and is 270 miles

long, and was caused, due to a fault line, or long fracture in the earth's crust.

- The Jordan winds through the northern part of this straight valley, and its steady flow, waters a green belt down the center of the valley's floor. South of the Dead Sea, however, the Arabah is fed only by seasonal torrent streams, that are insufficient to bring life to the dry soil.
- The whole land will be changed like the Arabah, from Geba to Rimmon to the south of Jerusalem, and she must rise and become inhabited in her place, from the Gate of Benjamin all the way to the place of the First Gate, all the way to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel all the way to the press vats of the king. (Zechariah 14:10)
- Then people will actually inhabit her, Jerusalem, and there will occur, no more, any banning to destruction, and from then on, Jerusalem will be inhabited in security.
- And people will certainly inhabit her, and there will occur no more any banning to destruction, and Jerusalem must be inhabited in security. (Zechariah 14:11)
- Also during the time of Christ's presence the Good News of God's Kingdom would be preached in all the inhabited earth, for a witness to those nations of the earth, and after this was completed then the complete end of the wicked system of things would unfold. This work has been taking place also in the past generation throughout the entire inhabited earth, and has been led by such groups as Jehovah's Witnesses and many others who would welcome the advent of a righteous rulership under the mighty hand of Yehowah God.
- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)
- Now in those days a decree went forth from the Roman emperor, Caesar Augustus, for a census, so that all the inhabited earth could be registered.
- Now in those days a decree went forth from Caesar Augustus for all the inhabited earth to be registered. (Luke 2:1)

- So then, Satan the Devil tried a different tack, and took Jesus and showed him all the kingdoms of the inhabited earth and all of their glory in an instant of time.
- So he brought him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the inhabited earth in an instant of time. (Luke 4:5)
- Jesus then showed, that during this time men would become faint out of fear and expectation, of the things that were coming in the near future upon the entire inhabited earth. Truly this is the present state of mind among the human family, despite the present ruler's efforts to play it down. Why? Because the powers of the heavens have been shaken, with the casting down to earth of Satan the Devil and his demons.
- While men become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Luke 21:26)
- Then all those who lived in that region and who inhabited Lydda on the plain of Sharon, saw this wonderful healing, and many of these ones turned to the Lord.
- And all those who inhabited Lydda and the plain of Sharon saw him, and these turned to the Lord. (Acts of Apostles 9:35)
- So one of these prophets named Agabus rose, and he proceeded to indicate through the Holy Spirit, that a great famine was about to come upon the entire inhabited earth, a famine that did in fact take place in the time of Emperor Claudius, the fourth emperor of Rome.
- One of them named Agabus rose and proceeded to indicate through the spirit that a great famine was about to come upon the entire inhabited earth, which, for that matter, did take place in the time of Claudius. (Acts of Apostles 11:28)
- So when they did not find Paul and Silas at Jason's house where they had been staying, they dragged out Jason and certain other brothers there, and they brought them before the city rulers, saying, that they were harboring men who had overturned the entire inhabited earth, and who were now present here, to disturb their city also.
- When they did not find them they dragged Jason and certain brothers to the city rulers, crying out; These men that have

overturned the inhabited earth are present here also. (Acts of Apostles 17:6)

- Then Paul showed, that he had set a day for the judgment of all the inhabited earth, and he had also appointed a man to do this judging, and he set a guarantee to all men that this judgment would ensue right on schedule, by resurrecting that man from the dead, when he was unjustly killed by his opposers. God would thus allow nothing to stop this coming judgment of all mankind.
- Because he has set a day in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men in that he has resurrected him from the dead. (Acts of Apostles 17:31)
- So Demetrius warned them, that the danger existed that their entire occupation would come into disrepute, and that even more serious was the danger, that the great temple of Artemis in their city would be esteemed as nothing. This great temple brought many to their city and brought wealth from those staying there. If this happened, then it would put them all out of work, and these arguments incited the people to riot.
- Moreover, the danger exists not only that this occupation of ours will come into disrepute but also that the temple of the great goddess Artemis will be esteemed as nothing and even her magnificence which the whole district of Asia and the inhabited earth worships is about to be brought down to nothing. (Acts of Apostles 19:27)
- He began by charging Paul with being a pestilent fellow who stirred up seditions among the Jews throughout the inhabited earth. He also accused Paul of being a spearhead, or tip of the spear, for the sect of the Nazarenes.
- For we have found this man a pestilent fellow and stirring up seditions among all the Jews throughout the inhabited earth and a spearhead of the sect of the Nazarenes. (Acts of Apostles 24:5)
- Paul here quotes (Psalms 19:1-4), which shows, that the creations of Yehowah do not speak, and yet they do say a great deal about the one who made them.
- Nevertheless I ask, they did not fail to hear, did they? Why, in

fact, into all the earth their sound went out, and to the extremities of the inhabited earth their utterances. (Romans 10:18)

- Paul now shows, that when God brings his firstborn Son into the inhabited earth he states; And let all God's angels do obeisance to him. Therefore this son is far higher than all the rest of the angels in heaven.
- But when he again brings his Firstborn into the inhabited earth, he says; And let all God's angels do obeisance to him. (Hebrews 1:6)
- Paul now reveals, that it is not to angels, that he has subjected the inhabited earth to come, which Paul and many others, are looking of forward to, in faith.
- For it is not to angels that he has subjected the inhabited earth to come, about which we are speaking. (Hebrews 2:5)
- The word about Christ's endurance is the truth about his integrity keeping course in the First Century. [See also, Son of Man Prophesy To The Wind]. Christ gave back to Yehowah God the exact value that our forefather Adam lost, perfect devotion, love and loyalty, along with fine conduct. In addition, Christ did this through persecution and many difficulties.
- Jehovah's Witnesses have held true to this standard better than anyone else. They have honored Christ by their Memorial celebrations and by their own integrity-keeping course in imitation of Jesus.
- All such ones, who have proven their integrity to Christ and devotion to divine principles, will be spared from the horrible end of this system of things, for as promised, I will keep you from the hour of test.
- Because you kept the word about my endurance, I will also keep you from the hour of test, which is to come upon the whole inhabited earth, to put a test upon those dwelling on the earth. (Revelation 3:10)
- Here the great dragon is clearly identified as the one who began this slander of God, becoming his resister and opposer. Throughout mankind's long history he has misled all of the inhabited earth by the means of false religion. Sometimes the falseness of a religion is more

obvious as in Buddhism or Confusism, and sometimes it is much more subtle as with Christendom and especially Jehovah's Witnesses.

- So down the great dragon was hurled, the original serpent, the one called Devil and Satan, who is misleading the entire inhabited earth, he was hurled down to the earth, and his angels were hurled down with him. (Revelation 12:9)
- The demons want Jehovah's Witnesses to kill newly anointed ones because this would thwart God's purposes. If Jehovah's Witnesses think that the gathering is already complete then they will fight against all of the new ones just as they have been doing for many years now. They want Jehovah's Witnesses not to recognize the Christ, and his ongoing presence, for this would expose them.
- They are, in fact, expressions inspired by demons and perform signs, and they go forth to the kings of the entire inhabited earth, to gather them together to the war of the great day of God the Almighty. (Revelation 16:14)
