

~INHABITING (280)

[English, living in, dwelling in, occupying, making your home in, dwelling in, populating]

- The men of Gibeon asked for Joshua's assistance against the men of the Amorites **inhabiting** the mountainous regions.
- Upon that the men of Gibeon sent to Joshua at the camp at Gilgal, saying; Do not let your hand relax from your slaves. Come up to us quickly and do save us and help us, for all the kings of the Amorites **inhabiting** the mountainous region have collected together against us. (**Joshua 10:6**)
- There proved to be no city that made peace with the sons of Israel but the Hivites **inhabiting** Gibeon. All the others they took by war. (**Joshua 11:19**)
- The sons of Judah went down to war against the Canaanites **inhabiting** the mountainous region of the Negeb.
- And afterward the sons of Judah went down to fight against the Canaanites **inhabiting** the mountainous region and the Negeb and the Shephelah. (**Judges 1:9**)
- But Judah marched on with Simeon his brother, and they proceeded to strike the Canaanites **inhabiting** Zephath and to devote it to destruction. Hence the name of the city was called Hormah. (**Judges 1:17**)
- The sons of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites **inhabiting** Jerusalem.
- And the sons of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites **inhabiting** Jerusalem, but the Jebusites keep on dwelling with the sons of Benjamin in Jerusalem down to this day. (**Judges 1:21**)
- The Asherites continued to dwell in among the Canaanites **inhabiting** the land.
- And the Asherites continued to dwell in among the Canaanites **inhabiting** the land, because they did not drive them out. (**Judges**

1:32)

- **Naphtali did not fully drive out the Canaanites *inhabiting* their land and continued to dwell with them.**
- **Naphtali did not drive out the inhabitants of Beth-shemesh and the inhabitants of Beth-anath, but they continued to dwell in among the Canaanites *inhabiting* the land, and the inhabitants of Beth-shemesh and of Beth-anath became theirs for forced labor. (**Judges 1:33**)**
- **Some people of *inhabiting* Canaan were allowed to remain so that future generations of Israelites could experience war with them.**
- **The five axis lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, even the Sidonians and the Hivites *inhabiting* Mount Lebanon from Mount Baal-hermon as far as to the entering in of Hamath. (**Judges 3:3**)**
- **Israel took possession of all the land of the Amorites *inhabiting* that land.**
- **At this Yehowah the God of Israel gave Sihon and all his people into Israel's hand, so that they struck them and Israel took possession of all the land of the Amorites *inhabiting* that land. (**Judges 11:21**)**
- **David with his men raided the Geshurites and Girzites and Amalekites *inhabiting* the land.**
- **And David proceeded to go up with his men that they might raid the Geshurites and the Girzites and the Amalekites, for they were *inhabiting* the land that extended from Telam as far as Shur and down to the land of Egypt. (**1 Samuel 27:8**)**
- **The king and his men went to Jerusalem warring against the Jebusites *inhabiting* the land.**
- **Consequently the king and his men went to Jerusalem against the Jebusites *inhabiting* the land, and they began to say to David; You will not come in here, but the blind and the lame ones will certainly turn you away, they thinking; David will not come in here. (**2 Samuel 5:6**)**

- The Jews **inhabiting** the cities of outlying districts were making the fourteenth day of Adar a day of rejoicing.
- That is why the country Jews, **inhabiting** the cities of the outlying districts, were making the fourteenth day of the month Adar a rejoicing and a banqueting and a good day and a sending of portions to one another. (**Esther 9:19**)
- Yehowah God is spoken of by the Psalmist as holy, **inhabiting** the praises of Israel.
- But you are holy, **inhabiting** the praises of Israel. (**Psalms 22:3**)
- The Psalmist speaks prophetically of Yehowah crushing Leviathan, giving him as food for those **inhabiting** the waterless regions.
- You yourself crushed to pieces the heads of Leviathan. You proceeded to give it as food to the people, to those **inhabiting** the waterless regions. (**Psalms 74:14**)
- Just as there were blessings for obeying the Law, there were also curses for rejecting it. (**Deuteronomy 30:15-20**). That is why, as a people, they were decreasing in numbers, and very few fine ones remained among them, **inhabiting** the land.
- That is why the curse itself has eaten up the land, and those **inhabiting** it are held guilty. That is why the inhabitants of the land have decreased in number, and very few mortal men have remained over. (**Isaiah 24:6**)
- As mighty King Nebuchadnezzar, one who then was **inhabiting** the heights, was later forced to confess. Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the heavens, because all his works are truth and his ways are justice, and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate. (**Daniel 4:37**)
- The **elevated town**, refers to **earth's religious and secular leaders, who have placed themselves high among all of earth's peoples**. He will abase them to the earth, demonstrating, that they are mere men, made of dust.
- For he has laid low those **inhabiting** the height, the elevated town. He abases it, he abases it to the earth, he brings it in

touch with the dust. (Isaiah 26:5)

- Then earthwide people will begin sing a **new song**, for Satan the Devil has been abyssed, and false religion has been debased. His glorious praise will now fill the earth, as many new books of praise are released, and they fill the earth with a resounding chorus of praise. Even religious **island nations** in the far-flung corners of the earth, will joyously sing this **new song among those inhabiting them**.
- Sing to Yehowah a new song, his praise from the extremity of the earth, you men that are going down to the sea and to that which fills it, you islands and you **inhabiting** them. (Isaiah 42:10)
- Likewise this Egyptian like system of things has covered the earth and dominated it for millenniums, and it thinks that its rule will forever dominate the earth. It too feels, that it can come up and destroy the great city, the greater Jerusalem, false religion, and the people **inhabiting** it, the religious peoples of the earth.
- Egypt itself comes up just like the Nile River, and like rivers the waters toss themselves. And it says, I shall go up. I shall cover the earth. I shall readily destroy the city and those **inhabiting** it. (Jeremiah 46:8)
- These flooding waters from the north, pictured the Babylonians coming from the north of the Promised Land, who would storm into the land like flooding waters and a torrent. They would sweep away all of the **inhabitants** of the land and desolate it. The people of the land would howl for their pain. Spiritually this flooding torrent is a flood of divine truth, that will sweep away the lies and half truths of Christendom bringing her ruin.
- This is what Yehowah has said; Look! Waters are coming up from the north and have become a flooding torrent. And they will flood the land and what fills it, the city and those **inhabiting** it. And the men will certainly cry out, and everyone dwelling in the land must howl. (Jeremiah 47:2)
- Jehovah's Witnesses reach out into 235 lands and islands of the sea. After their world headquarters is struck the governments will turn against her and all other religions worldwide. These **religious island nations** that garnered support from peoples all over the world will be no more.

- They have all become strong as traveling merchants pedaling their wares all over the earth. She has filled the earth with terror, especially Christendom and the Jews, by their violence and hatreds stemming from false religious teachings.
- And they must raise up over you a dirge and say to you; How you have perished, that used to be inhabited from the seas, O praised city, who became a strong one in the sea, she and those **inhabiting** her, those who gave their terror to all the inhabitants of the earth! (**Ezekiel 26:17**)
- Magog was a land far away from ancient Israel and so this shows that rebels to Yehowah even in the most far away places and those **inhabiting** islands which might be quite isolated will be searched out and given attention by Yehowah. People will then have to know that Yehowah will rid the earth of all those in opposition to his rightful rule. The way of righteousness will be the way forever more upon the earth.
- And I will send fire upon Magog and upon those who are **inhabiting** the islands in security, and people will have to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 39:6**)
- Then Yehowah calls for woe upon those inhabiting the region of the sea, the nation of the Cherethites. For the word of Yehowah is against those people, even all of Canaan, and the land of the Philistines, people who have given themselves over to badness and wickedness, to do it well. Yehowah then promises to destroy them, so that they have no **inhabitants**, or offspring, a complete annihilation.
- Woe to those **inhabiting** the region of the sea, the nation of Cherethites! The word of Yehowah is against you people. O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will also destroy you, so that there will be no inhabitant. (**Zephaniah 2:5**)
- He also showed that whoever swore by the temple, and really any part of it, was swearing by, and before, the spirit **inhabiting** it, Yehowah God, their spiritual father.
- And he that swears by the temple is swearing by it and by him that is **inhabiting** it. (**Matthew 23:21**)
- Then Jesus showed another example, that of a tower that fell upon eighteen men in Siloam, thereby killing them all. Then he asked them, if they imagined that these eighteen men were any greater

debtors or sinners, than other men **inhabiting** Jerusalem at the same time.

- Or those eighteen upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, thereby killing them, do you imagine that they were proved greater debtors than all other men **inhabiting** Jerusalem? (**Luke 13:4**)
- So the apostle Paul kept teaching in this school auditorium for two years, and so during this time all those **inhabiting** the district of Asia got to hear the word of God, both Jews and Greeks.
- This took place for two years, so that all those **inhabiting** the district of Asia heard the word of the Lord, both Jews and Greeks. (**Acts of Apostles 19:10**)
