

~INJURIOUS (312)

[English, harmful, damaging, detrimental, adverse, deleterious, ruinous, Opposite of, harmless]

- One promised blessing of Israel was that Yehowah God would cause the **injurious** wild beast to pass out of their land.
- And I will put peace in the land, and you will indeed lie down, with no one making you tremble, and I will make the **injurious** wild beast cease out of the land, and a sword will not pass through your land. (**Leviticus 26:6**)
- After Elisha threw flour into the pot of stew, nothing **injurious** proved to be within it after that.
- So he said; Fetch, then, flour. After he threw it into the pot, he went on to say; Pour out for the people that they may eat. And nothing **injurious** proved to be in the pot. (**2 Kings 4:41**)
- Eliphaz said that in six distresses God would deliver man, and in seven, nothing **injurious** would touch him.
- In six distresses he will deliver you, and in seven nothing **injurious** will touch you. (**Job 5:19**)
- Yehowah is spoken of by the Psalmist as the one setting David his servant free from the **injurious** sword.
- The One giving salvation to kings, the One setting David his servant free from the **injurious** sword. (**Psalms 144:10**)
- Israel thought up an **injurious** scheme, trying to replace and depose Judah's king with Tabeel, a man of their choosing, but Yehowah was against them and their designs, shattering them to pieces. Should they gird up for war against Judah, then Yehowah would surely shatter them to pieces. Distant and mighty nations should take note, for Yehowah himself has spoken.
- Be **injurious**, O you peoples, and be shattered to pieces, and give ear, all you in distant parts of the earth! Gird yourselves, and be shattered to pieces! Gird yourselves, and be shattered to pieces! (**Isaiah 8:9**)

- **Injurious** arrows are the first part of the assault on a city. They are sent over the wall from a distance before the main assault on the wall and gates begins. Likewise armies surround a city attacking from a distance and causing famine inside the walls. Jehovah's Witnesses today are without continuing spiritual food from Yehowah.

- They are unfaithful, focusing their study of God's word on times long past and not applying it to present and future. They have books to read and study, but in the last 20 years since the **Revelation Climax** book was published, they have not produced any deep spiritual books nor shown insight into God's forward moving purposes.

- Most of their seven million members have never even seen much less studied a deeply spiritual book because they just don't make them anymore. Yehowah has broken their connection to his **rod** of truth and so there is no bread. Surely famine will result!

- When I send the **injurious** arrows of the famine upon them, which must prove to be for ruination, which arrows I shall send to bring you people to ruin, even famine I shall increase upon you people and I will break your rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended. (**Ezekiel 5:16**)

- Their city is under siege and for 20 years now her food supplies have been dwindling. Her **leaders** have no answers and so they have become like unreasoning wild beasts. They have deprived her of her spiritual children by disfellowshipping many newly anointed ones. A pestilence of immorality is about to be exposed in her.

- Yehowah's long sword of Bible truth will expose all of the blood guiltiness and leave her devastated. Just as Yehowah brought a devastation upon ancient Jerusalem in **607 B.C.E.** for her injustices and iniquity, so now he will judge Jehovah's Witnesses, giving them over to the sword of the nations and dispersing them to every wind.

- And I will send upon you people famine and **injurious** wild beasts, and they must bereave you of children, and pestilence and blood themselves will pass along through you, and a sword I shall bring in upon you. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. (**Ezekiel 5:17**)

- **Injurious** wild beasts are a symbol of wicked religious rulers who act beastlike toward the flock. They bereave the land of young ones, because children are what make the organization grow.
- The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses have acted like wild beasts who have bereaved the land of all of its young anointed ones. They have left the land desolate and filled with blood in Yehowah's eyes. Soon Yehowah will desolate all of their land emptying it of all of its children, new Christians.
- Or if I should make **injurious** wild beasts pass through the land and they actually bereaved it of children and it actually became a desolate waste without anybody passing through on account of the wild beasts. (**Ezekiel 14:15**)
- But is Yehowah just postulating on how to bring the city to ruin? No! For all four of these ruinous judgments will come upon her. The entire land must be cleared of all of its inhabitants and its bloodguilt cleansed. These four ruinous actions also have spiritual counterparts.
- The **sword**, **destruction by the nations**, the **famine**, **Yehowah cutting off spiritual food** from them, the **wild beasts**, **destruction from injurious religious leaders**, and the **pestilence**, a **plague of immorality**.
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; So, too, it will be when there will be my four **injurious** acts of judgment, sword and famine and injurious wild beast and pestilence, that I shall actually send upon Jerusalem in order to cut off from it earthling man and domestic animal. (**Ezekiel 14:21**)
- Yehowah will bring peace to all of his people by means of his spirit. He will clearly delineate through his word and spirit, who his chieftain, his Faithful and Discreet Slave really is. (**Genesis 41:37-46**) The book, **Revealing The Sons Of God**, will cause the **injurious wild beasts**, **the nations rulers and religious rulers** who act like them to cease out of the land. There will be no one then to make them fear or tremble.
- And I will conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall certainly cause the **injurious** wild beast to cease out of the land, and they will actually dwell in the wilderness in security and sleep in the forests. (**Ezekiel 34:25**)

- When Satan comes back from the abyss after a thousand years he will realize that Yehowah's kingdom has brought peace worldwide just as God has promised. He will realize that he is about to lose all of his arguments and so he will draw up an **injurious** scheme to entrap as many as possible of the sons of men. He will still be bent on defeating God and his purpose.
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; And it must occur in that day that things will come up into your heart, and you will certainly think up an **injurious** scheme. (**Ezekiel 38:10**)
- Jesus then elucidated on what he meant by that. It was out of the heart of men that wicked thinking, or **injurious** reasonings came forth. Things such as fornications, thievery and murder. These were they unlawful acts that defiled a man.
- For from inside, out of the heart of men, **injurious** reasonings issue forth, fornications, thieveries, murders. (**Mark 7:21**)
- Then the Greater Abraham, Yehowah God will say to them, that they should remember that during their lifetimes they had all the best of everything, and by contrast then, that Lazarus got the worst or **injurious** part of everything. So that now Lazarus is having comfort and they are in anguish.
- This is how it will be for all those who take enjoy every material advantage now, but who disregard the finer spiritual principles guiding our lives. Their advantage is a fleeting one, one that will not endure, while the blessing of Lazarus is everlasting. They will only see this when their lives are over and judgment comes, thus leaving them in anguish that they did not act differently during their time of testing. Also this anguish will be everlasting, for it will never end.
- But Abraham said; Child, remember that you received in full your good things in your lifetime, but Lazarus correspondingly the **injurious** things. Now, however, he is having comfort here but you are in anguish. (**Luke 16:25**)
- Yet Ananias knew of the work of Saul, for he had heard about him previously, and of all the **injurious** things he had done to other faithful Christians in Jerusalem.
- But Ananias answered; Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how many **injurious** things he did to your holy ones in

Jerusalem. (**Acts of Apostles 9:13**)

- They develop bad qualities, because they are haters of God and his righteous way. Rather than learning to exercise godly qualities like brotherly love, warmth and compassion, and love for the truth and mercy, they develop wicked ones, like the ones mentioned above.
- Backbiters, haters of God, insolent, haughty, self-assuming, inventors of **injurious** things, disobedient to parents. (**Romans 1:30**)
- What then, will come upon people, who refuse to come to repentance, and have to experience God's wrath? They will experience tribulation and distresses of every kind, in the day of his judgment. This wrath will be poured out upon everyone doing works that are **injurious** to others, to the Jew first, and then also upon all other peoples, which Paul referred to here as the Greeks.
- Tribulation and distress, upon the soul of every man who works what is **injurious**, of the Jew first and also of the Greek. (**Romans 2:9**)
- How would we feel if we stumbled a Christian brother over mere food or drink? All foods are clean according to Christ. But if a Christian brother has weaker faith, and thinks in his own mind that what we are doing is wrong, then we are wrong to do it, even though, it is approved by God for us to do it.
- Stop tearing down the work of God just for the sake of food. True, all things are clean, but it is **injurious** to the man who with an occasion for stumbling eats. (**Romans 14:20**)
- These things were prophetic examples of persons desiring **injurious** things, and what Yehowah would do to them, if they persisted in such behavior. Christians are to put to death the desires of their sinful flesh by means of their love of the spirit, something that those Israelites lacked. Therefore they cannot act in the same manner as those who fell, or they will certainly encounter the same bad outcome.
- Now these things became our examples, for us not to be persons desiring **injurious** things, even as they desired them. (**1 Corinthians 10:6**)

- The love of money is where many **injuriously** things get a start in our lives. By reaching out for this love, some people have been led away from the faith, and have stabbed themselves all over with many pains.
- The faith we have, is that we must follow the lead of Christ, and put the desires of our flesh, to death through our love of the Holy Spirit within us, through our spirit anointing. To keep reaching out for more and more material things, is in direct opposition to his course, and it will cause us to stumble.
- Christians who are focused properly spiritually, live a simple life, one that is focused upon service to God, and to the needs of others and of the congregation. They do not care, if they do not have all the things, that people of the world generally possess, for their efforts are self-sacrificing, and directed toward others, for their good.
- For the love of money is a root of all sorts of **injuriously** things, and by reaching out for this love some have been led astray from the faith and have stabbed themselves all over with many pains. (**1 Timothy 6:10**)
- Paul now quotes from a certain one of their number, who thinks himself to be a prophet who has said; Cretans are always liars, **injuriously** wild beasts, unemployed gluttons.
- A certain one of them, their own prophet, said; Cretans are always liars, **injuriously** wild beasts, unemployed gluttons. (**Titus 1:12**)
- Yet the tongue is something that not even one man has demonstrated the ability to completely control. It proves to be an unruly and **injuriously** member as part of the members of our bodies, one that is full of death-dealing poison. It therefore spews out venom like a snake through hateful thoughts and vicious accusations and bragging and boasting and hatred.
- But the tongue, not one of mankind can get it tamed. An unruly **injuriously** thing, it is full of death-dealing poison. (**James 3:8**)
