

## **~INNOCENCY (27)**

**[English, Condition of being, blameless, pure, virtuous, incorruptible,  
Opposite of, guilty]**

- Abimelech stated before God that it was in **innocency**, that he had taken Sarai to himself.
- Did not he say to me, She is my sister? And she, did not she too say; He is my brother? In the honesty of my heart and with **innocency** of my hands I have done this. (**Genesis 20:5**)
- The Psalmist stated that he shall wash his hands in **innocency** itself and march around Yehowah's altar in praise.
- I shall wash my hands in **innocency** itself, and I will march around your altar, O Yehowah. (**Psalms 26:6**)
- Yehowah described Israel as incapable of **innocency** because from their inception they had worshiped a golden calf idol and created priests for themselves and walked away from Yehowah's true worship in Judah.
- Your calf has been cast off, O Samaria. My anger has grown hot against them. How long will they be incapable of **innocency**? (**Hosea 8:5**)
