~INQUIRED (234)

[English, asked, queried, requested, questioned, made inquiries, found out]

- Jacob inquired of the angel as to his name.
- In turn Jacob inquired and said; Tell me, please, your name. However, he said; Why is it that you inquire for my name? With that he blessed him there. (Genesis 32:29)
- A man found Joseph wandering in a field and inquired of him what he was looking for.
- Later a man found him and here he was wandering in a field.
 Then the man inquired of him, saying; What are you looking for?
 (Genesis 37:15)
- Joseph's brothers later told their father that the man in charge of the foodstuffs in Egypt directly inquired of them about their father and brothers.
- At this they said; The man directly inquired concerning us and our relatives, saying; Is your father yet alive? Do you have another brother? And we went on to tell him according to these facts. How could we know for certain that he would say; Bring your brother down? (Genesis 43:7)
- Jacob inquired of his brothers whether their father was getting along well.
- After this he inquired whether they were getting along well and said; Is your father, the aged man of whom you have spoken, getting along well? Is he still alive? (Genesis 43:27)
- The sons of Israel inquired of Yehowah God as to whether to go up and war against their brother tribe of Benjamin.
- Then the sons of Israel went up and wept before Yehowah until the evening and inquired of Yehowah, saying; Shall I again approach for battle against the sons of Benjamin my brother? To this Yehowah said; Go up against him. (Judges 20:23)

- The sons of Israel inquired of Yehowah God at Bethel where the ark of the covenant was then being kept.
- After that the sons of Israel inquired of Yehowah, as it was there that the ark of the covenant of the true God was in those days. (Judges 20:27)
- Samuel inquired of the men of Benjamin as to whether Saul had come there as yet.
- Hence they inquired further of Yehowah; Has the man come here as yet? To this Yehowah said; Here he is, hidden among the luggage. (1 Samuel 10:22)
- When David inquired of Yehowah God he told him to go up against the Philistines in battle, and that he would win.
- So David inquired yet again of Yehowah. Yehowah now answered him and said; Rise up, go down to Keilah, because I am giving the Philistines into your hand. (1 Samuel 23:4)
- At that David inquired of Yehowah, but he said; You must not go up. Go around to the rear of them, and you must come against them in front of the baca bushes. (2 Samuel 5:23)
- At that David inquired again of God, and the true God now said to him; You must not go up after them. Go around from directly against them, and you must come at them in front of the baca bushes. (1 Chronicles 14:14)
- David sent and inquired about the woman he saw bathing, Bathsheba.
- Then David sent and inquired about the woman and someone said; Is this not Bath-sheba the daughter of Eliam the wife of Uriah the Hittite? (2 Samuel 11:3)
- Hezekiah inquired, concerning the heaps to the priests and Levites.
- In time Hezekiah inquired of the priests and the Levites concerning the heaps. (2 Chronicles 31:9)

- The Psalmist inquired of Yehowah God, and he answered him and delivered him out of all his frights.
- I inquired of Yehowah, and he answered me, and out of all my frights he delivered me. (Psalms 34:4)
- When Yehowah God disciplined his people they would turn and inquire of him, looking for their God.
- As often as he killed them, they also inquired for him, and they returned and looked for God. (Psalms 78:34)
- Jehovah's Witnesses today brag in the strength of their seven million members, that they are like a mighty nation in the earth, and that their leaders would be powerful men in industry and commerce. Does this sound like humble dependence on Yehowah God, or a trusting in one's own might? Trusting in the same things, that this system trusts in, will not bringing salvation, nor Yehowah's blessing.
- Those who are setting out to go down to Egypt and who have not inquired of my own mouth, to take shelter in the stronghold of Pharaoh and to take refuge in the shadow of Egypt! (Isaiah 30:2)
- The dungy idols of the Great Crowd are the Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses. They are mere men but the Great Crowd treat them as God's. Whatever they tell local elders to do, they do, because they will not be elders for long if they do not comply. The Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses is the stumbling block causing their error and they put it in front of their faces by bowing to its will. They put its wishes ahead of what is scriptural and what is right. Shall Yehowah God ever be inquired of by such men.
- Son of man, as regards these men, they have brought up their dungy idols upon their heart, and the stumbling block causing their error they have put in front of their faces. Shall I be inquired of at all by them? (Ezekiel 14:3)
- Now they are living under more harsh conditions in Babylonian exile. So they come in before the Son of Man, God's prophet, to inquire of Yehowah. Should Yehowah let himself be inquired of by men who have rejected the Son of Man, his only mediator?
- Son of man, speak with the elderly men of Israel, and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said;

Is it in order to inquire of me that you men are coming? As I am alive, I will not be inquired of by you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 20:3)

- It is not now, nor was it ever God's will or his thinking, to find petty faults with his anointed sons and then to stumble them out of the truth. These men, the Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses, like the kings of Israel and Judah, are destroying their firstborn sons, by making them pass through the fire. At the same time the Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses gets and seeks god-like status among them. Will God answer the prayers of such wicked men? Will he give them any insight when they inquire of him.?
- And in lifting up your gifts by making your sons pass through the fire, are you defiling yourselves for all your dungy idols down till today? At the same time shall I myself be inquired of by you people, O house of Israel? As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, I will not be inquired of by you. (Ezekiel 20:31)
- During this time of the end, these four men have been given wisdom and understanding ten times better, than the understanding of all of Babylon's other magic-practicing priests, Christendom's clergy.
- They have continued to stand before the King, when others have fallen, because he finds in them fine qualities like wisdom, insight and understanding. For this reason, he has exalted them above all other magic practicing priests in his kingdom. They have compiled this wisdom and understanding over the years into many books, publications and Watchtower articles.
- And as regards every matter of wisdom and understanding that the king inquired about from them, he even got to find them ten times better than all the magic-practicing priests and the conjurers that were in all his royal realm. (Daniel 1:20)
- Also he will then come against all those who are drawing back from Yehowah God, who, though claiming to be his worshipers, have themselves not sought him out, and have not inquired of him, so as to truly come to know his will and purpose.
- And those who are drawing back from following Yehowah and who have not sought Yehowah and have not inquired of him. (Zephaniah 1:6)

- So the older son inquired of one of his father's servants, what all this boisterous activity was about.
- So he called one of the servants to him and inquired what these things meant. (Luke 15:26)
- So they called out and inquired to Simon, as to whether a man named Peter was staying there at his home.
- And they called out and inquired whether Simon who was surnamed Peter was being entertained there. (Acts of Apostles 10:18)
- So the governor Felix, read the note, and inquired of Paul what province he emanated from, and ascertained that Paul was from Tarsus in the province of Cilicia.
- So he read it and inquired from what province he was, and ascertained that he was from Cilicia. (Acts of Apostles 23:34)
