~INQUIRY (88) [English, question, query]

- Moses told the people to go to the priests and Levites judging in that day and make inquiry regarding Yehowah God's judicial decisions then.
- And you must go to the priests, the Levites, and to the judge who will be acting in those days, and you must make inquiry, and they must hand down to you the word of the judicial decision.

 (Deuteronomy 17:9)
- Saul felt that his men had acted unfaithfully by making inquiry of Yehowah God, in David's behalf.
- And Saul went on to say to him; Why have you men conspired against me, you and the son of Jesse, by your giving him bread and a sword, and there being an inquiry of God for him, to rise up against me as a lier in ambush the way it is this day? (1 Samuel 22:13)
- Saul later died for making an inquiry of a spirit medium, when Yehowah God had turned his face away from him.
- Thus Saul died for his unfaithfulness with which he had acted faithlessly against Yehowah concerning the word of Yehowah that he had not kept and also for asking of a spirit medium to make inquiry. (1 Chronicles 10:13)
- The house of Israel today is the anointed and the Great Crowd and the alien residents among them, those who study with them. The Son of Man, will turn all away making inquiry, who hold up their Governing Body as objects of reverence, and who put the Governing Body's word and wishes above or in front of Yehowah and his word the Bible. The Son of Man will have nothing to with them and will let Yehowah bring them into judgment and deal with them personally.
- For any man at all from the house of Israel or from the alien residents that reside as aliens in Israel, that withdraws himself from following me and that brings up his dungy idols upon his heart and that sets the very stumbling block causing his error in front of his face and that actually comes to the prophet to make

inquiry for himself by me, I, Yehowah, I am letting myself be brought to answer him by myself. (Ezekiel 14:7)

- If we go to a store to buy meat, then we are under no obligation to make inquiry about what was done to the meat before we bought it. We do not need to know if it was offered to idols before being sold to us.
- Everything that is sold in a meat market keep eating, making no inquiry on account of your conscience. (1 Corinthians 10:25)
- Next Paul shows, that if an unbeliever invites us to his house for a meal, where the meat may have been offered to an idol, that we need not make any inquiry, on account of our own conscience, for we are not there to worship, but to eat and likely to talk about our God.
- If anyone of the unbelievers invites you and you wish to go, proceed to eat everything that is set before you, making no inquiry on account of your conscience. (1 Corinthians 10:27)
- Peter now shows that this salvation that they are reaching out for, is one that has long been the subject of the inquiries of the ancient prophets, who spoke by means of Holy Spirit. They repeatedly spoke about this undeserved kindness of God that these anointed ones are now experiencing. These prophets searched out the spirit within them to carefully search out the future as the spirit revealed it to them.
- Concerning this very salvation a diligent inquiry and a careful search were made by the prophets who prophesied about the undeserved kindness meant for you. (1 Peter 1:10)
