[English, adamant, firm, persistent, unrelenting, resolute, persevering]

- Lot was very **insistent** with the angels who had been sent to inspect the city to come into his house.
- But he was very **insistent** with them, so that they turned aside to him and came into his house. Then he made a feast for them, and he baked unfermented cakes, and they went to eating. (**Genesis 19:3**)
- The Jewish religious leaders became very **insistent** with Pilate stating that Jesus stirred up the people by his teachings those Judea.
- But they began to be **insistent**, saying; He stirs up the people by teaching throughout all Judea, even starting out from Galilee to here. (**Luke 23:5**)
