- Jehoash continued to do right before Yehowah God as long as
 Jehoiada the priest instructed him.
- And Jehoash continued doing what was right in Yehowah's eyes all the days of his that Jehoiada the priest instructed him. (2 Kings 12:2)
- The Psalmist did not turn aside from Yehowah God's judicial decisions, for he had instructed him personally.
- From your judicial decisions I have not turned aside, for you yourself have instructed me. (Psalms 119:102)
- So the soldiers took the bribe offered to them and maintained this false account of what had actually happened to Jesus' body as they had been instructed, and the populous took to accepting this story as fact, because a number of witnesses falsely agreed to it.
- So they took the silver pieces and did as they were instructed, and this saying has been spread abroad among the Jews up to this very day. (Matthew 28:15)
- Then Jesus instructed the people to lie down on the grass in companies, so that they could partake of Yehowah's goodness together.
- And he instructed all the people to recline by companies on the green grass. (Mark 6:39)
- So Jesus himself instructed the crowds to recline on the ground. Then he took the seven loaves, and after saying a prayer to God of thanks, he began to break the loaves and to give them to his disciples to serve, and they in turn, served them to the assembled crowd.
- And he instructed the crowd to recline on the ground, and he took the seven loaves, gave thanks, broke them, and began to give them to his disciples to serve, and they served them to the crowd. (Mark 8:6)

- Jesus then showed, that no pupil is ever above his teacher, for the pupil can only draw from the riches of his instructor. Yet, nonetheless every person who is perfectly instructed would become like his teacher. This also is a divine principle, that holds true in every aspect of life.
- A pupil is not above his teacher, but everyone that is perfectly instructed will be like his teacher. (Luke 6:40)
- At the sight of this her parents were besides themselves with pure joy. Yet Jesus instructed all those there, to tell no one of what had happened.
- Well, her parents were beside themselves, but he instructed them to tell no one what had happened. (Luke 8:56)
- So then Jesus gave them a stern talk, and instructed them not to be telling this to anyone.
- Then in a stern talk to them he instructed them not to be telling this to anybody. (Luke 9:21)
- So because of being raised within the house of Pharaoh, Moses was instructed in all the wisdom of the Egyptians. And he grew strong and mighty, both in his words and his deeds.
- Consequently Moses was instructed in all the wisdom of the Egyptians. In fact, he was powerful in his words and deeds. (Acts of Apostles 7:22)
- This man Apollos had been orally instructed in Christian teachings, and he was aglow with the spirit. Thus he went speaking and teaching the Jews there, with correctness, the things about Jesus Christ. He though, was only acquainted with the baptism of John the Baptist.
- This man had been orally instructed in the way of Yehowah and, as he was aglow with the spirit, he went speaking and teaching with correctness the things about Jesus, but being acquainted with only the baptism of John. (Acts of Apostles 18:25)
- Then Paul told them, that he was a Jew born in Tarsus of Cilicia, and he had been instructed by the very learned and well respected

man, Gamaliel, whom many of them knew. He had been properly instructed in all the details of their ancestral Law, and he was just as zealous for God, as all of them were this very day.

- I am a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but educated in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, instructed according to the strictness of the ancestral Law, being zealous for God just as all of you are this day. (Acts of Apostles 22:3)
- As Jews they are instructed in the requirements of the Law Covenant by their faithful priesthood. They say, that they approve of the good things of the Law Covenant. Yet they are not living up to it.
- And you know his will and approve of things that are excellent because you are orally instructed out of the Law. (Romans 2:18)
