## ~INSTRUCTING (41)

[English, teaching, training, coaching, tutoring, educating, drilling, inculcating, initiating]

- Nehemiah and Ezra and the Levites were instructing the people upon their return to Jerusalem after the exile.
- And Nehemiah, that is, the Tirshatha, and Ezra the priest, the copyist, and the Levites who were instructing the people proceeded to say to all the people; This very day is holy to Yehowah your God. Do not mourn or weep. For all the people were weeping as they were hearing the words of the Law. (Nehemiah 8:9)
- Again Jesus instructed the crowds to recline upon the ground so that they could share a meal together.
- So, after instructing the crowd to recline upon the ground. (Matthew 15:35)
- Timothy must be able to still instruct with mildness, those who would argue with him. In all such situations, he should hope, that God will give them repentance, which leads to an accurate knowledge of the truth.
- Instructing with mildness those not favorably disposed, as perhaps God may give them repentance leading to an accurate knowledge of truth. (2 Timothy 2:25)
- This undeserved kindness of God, has instructed men to repudiate ungodliness, and worldly desires, and to live in this, Satan the Devil's world, with soundness of mind and righteousness and godly devotion.
- Instructing us to repudiate ungodliness and worldly desires and to live with soundness of mind and righteousness and godly devotion amid this present system of things. (Titus 2:12)
