

~INSTRUCTIONS (83)

[English, orders, commands, directions, directives, advice, information]

- The priests were to give **instructions** when something was unclean.
- In order to give **instructions** when something is unclean and when something is clean. This is the Law about leprosy. (**Leviticus 14:57**)
- Thus Jesus **instructions** were finished toward his disciples before he sent them out to preach, and they set out in pairs to the different cities where he was going to come. They then went through these many cities preaching and teaching about the Kingdom of God.
- Now when Jesus had finished giving **instructions** to his twelve disciples, he set out from there to teach and preach in their cities. (**Matthew 11:1**)
- Then they related to him, that they were all servants of a man, an army officer name Cornelius, and that this man was well reported upon by all the Jews. This man had been given **instruction** by an angel of Yehowah God, to come to this very house and to seek out Peter, so that Peter could return with them, and they could listen to all that Peter had to say to them.
- They said; Cornelius, an army officer, a man righteous and fearing God and well reported by the whole nation of the Jews, was given divine **instructions** by a holy angel to send for you to come to his house and to hear the things you have to say. (**Acts of Apostles 10:22**)
- They showed, that it had come to their attention, that a great deal of disputing was going on about what things were necessary for Christians to practice, because some men from among them there in Jerusalem, that they did not send out or commission, had gone there and had been trying to subvert their souls, though they received no **instruction** to do so.
- Since we have heard that some from among us have caused you trouble with speeches, trying to subvert your souls, although we did not give them any **instructions**. (**Acts of Apostles 15:24**)

- So then the group traveling with Paul then boarded a boat, and set sail for Assos, where they intended to take Paul aboard, for this was the previous **instruction** that he had given them, but he was intending to go there on foot by himself.
- We now went ahead to the boat and set sail to Assos, where we were intending to take Paul aboard, for, after giving **instructions** to this effect, he himself was intending to go on foot. (**Acts of Apostles 20:13**)
- Paul now gives **instructions** to women who are having marital problems to remain with her husband, not to leave him. She should try to work out these problems and reach a peaceful solution. After all she took vows before Yehowah God to marry for life, and only death or fornication breaks the marriage covenant before God.
- To the married people I give **instructions**, yet not I but the Lord, that a wife should not depart from her husband. (**1 Corinthians 7:10**)
- Paul now disciplines the congregation in Corinth for he says, that it is not for the better, but for the worse, that they are coming together in worship, in relation to the Memorial celebration.
- But, while giving these **instructions**, I do not commend you because it is, not for the better, but for the worse that you meet together. (**1 Corinthians 11:17**)
