Opposite of, **stupid**]

- David was a man skilled at playing musical instruments, a valiant mighty man, well formed or handsome, and an **intelligent** speaker, but most importantly Yehowah God was with him.
- And one of the attendants proceeded to answer and say; Look! I have seen how a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite is skilled at playing, and he is a valiant, mighty man and a man of war and an **intelligent** speaker and a well-formed man, and Yehowah is with him. (**1 Samuel 16:18**)
- Ezra gathered together all the people the ones **intelligent** enough to listen to the Law.
- Accordingly Ezra the priest brought the Law before the congregation of men as well as of women and of all **intelligent** enough to listen, on the first day of the seventh month. (**Nehemiah 8:2**)
- And he continued to read aloud from it before the public square that is before the Water Gate, from daybreak till midday, in front of the men and the women and the other **intelligent** ones, and the ears of all the people were attentive to the book of the Law. (**Nehemiah 8:3**)
- Luke describes the proconsul as an **intelligent** man, that Paul and Barnabas witnessed to.
- And he was with the proconsul Sergius Paulus, an **intelligent** man. Calling Barnabas and Saul to him, this man earnestly sought to hear the word of God. (**Acts of Apostles 13:7**)
