

~INTENSELY (270)

[English, powerfully, strongly, deeply, very much, extremely, hugely, mildly]

- **Moses asked for Yehowah God to make the enemies of Israel who **intensely** hated them to flee from them.**
- **And it would occur that when the Ark would set out, Moses would say; Do arise, O Yehowah, and let your enemies be scattered, and let those who **intensely** hate you flee from before you. (Numbers 10:35)**
- **Bless, O Yehowah, his vital energy, and may you show pleasure in the activity of his hands. Wound severely in their hips those who rise up against him, and those who **intensely** hate him, that they may not rise up. (Deuteronomy 33:11)**
- **And as for my enemies, you will certainly give me the back of their neck, those hating me **intensely**, I shall also silence them. (2 Samuel 22:41)**
- **Through Moses Yehowah God promised to pay back vengeance against all those **intensely** hating him.**
- **If I do indeed sharpen my glittering sword, and my hand takes hold on judgment, I will pay back vengeance to my adversaries and render retribution to those who **intensely** hate me. (Deuteronomy 32:41)**
- **Job showed that he would have been in the wrong to rejoice at the extinction of one **intensely** hating him.**
- **If I used to rejoice at the extinction of one **intensely** hating me, or I felt excited because evil had found him. (Job 31:29)**
- **The Psalmist showed that Yehowah God would give him the back of the neck of those **intensely** hating him, for they would flee from him.**
- **And as for my enemies, you will certainly give me the back of their neck, and as for those hating me **intensely**, I shall silence them. (Psalms 18:40)**

- The Psalmist showed that Yehowah God had many times saved his people Israel from the hands of those **intensely** hating them.
- For you saved us from our adversaries, and those **intensely** hating us you put to shame. (**Psalms 44:7**)
- The Psalmist showed that at times Yehowah God let his disobedient people suffer at the hands of the people **intensely** hating them.
- You keep making us turn back from the adversary, and the very ones **intensely** hating us have pillaged for themselves. (**Psalms 44:10**)
- The Psalmist prophesied that those **intensely** hating Yehowah God would in time come cringing to him.
- As for those **intensely** hating Yehowah, they will come cringing to him, and their time will prove to be to time indefinite. (**Psalms 81:15**)
- The Psalmist called Yehowah God's attention to his enemies who were in an uproar, for the ones **intensely** hating Yehowah God had raised their heads.
- For, look! Your very enemies are in an uproar, and the very ones **intensely** hating you have raised their head. (**Psalms 83:2**)
- The Psalmist kept dealing out blows to all those **intensely** hating Yehowah God.
- And from before him I crushed his adversaries to pieces, and to those **intensely** hating him I kept dealing out blows. (**Psalms 89:23**)
- The Psalmist hated those who themselves **intensely** hated Yehowah God, and felt a loathing against those revolting against him.
- Do I not hate those who are **intensely** hating you, O Yehowah, and do I not feel a loathing for those revolting against you? (**Psalms 139:21**)
- All those **intensely** hating Yehowah God are the ones who love death.

- But the one missing me is doing violence to his soul, all those **intensely** hating me are the ones that do love death. (**Proverbs 8:36**)
- Yehowah God showed through Jeremiah that his efforts at **intensely** refining his people down through time, had proved to be for nothing, he getting only bad results for his efforts.
- The bellows have been scorched. Out from their fire there is lead. One has kept refining **intensely** simply for nothing, and those who are bad have not been separated. (**Jeremiah 6:29**)
- Lebanon, Bashan, the land of their brother nation of Israel, had already been broken, and so all of Judah's **cries** for help will go wanting. The ones **intensely loving** her, have been broken.
- Go up onto Lebanon and cry out, and on Bashan let your voice out. And cry out from Abarim, because all those **intensely** loving you have been broken. (**Jeremiah 22:20**)
- Yehowah, the great shepherd, will shepherd all of the false shepherds who have abused his sheep among his people, with a wind of judgment. It will be a destructive wind and one that will cause Christendom and Judaism's downfall. Their calamity will cause them to feel humiliated for currently they act as if they can do no wrong and so they rebuff all counsel.
- A wind will shepherd all your own shepherds, and as for those **intensely** loving you, they will go into captivity itself. For at that time you will be ashamed and certainly feel humiliated because of all your calamity. (**Jeremiah 22:22**)
- All of the ones **intensely** loving Jerusalem, and the principles and ideals that she once stood for, had forgotten her. No one within her, was still searching for goodness and her interests for the future.
- This made Yehowah act like an enemy toward her, holding back his mercy and executing judgment within her. Her errors were just too numerous, for there to be forgiveness. The day of her accounting had come, and she would not be healed.
- All those **intensely** loving you are the ones that have forgotten you. You are not the one for whom they keep searching. For

with the stroke of an enemy I have struck you, with the chastisement of someone cruel, on account of the abundance of your error, your sins have become numerous. ([Jeremiah 30:14](#))

- Yehowah repeatedly called out through his many prophets to a people **intensely** loving him, but they were a self involved people and paid no attention.
- I have called to those **intensely** loving me. They themselves have tricked me. In the city my own priests and my own old men have expired, while they had to look for something to eat for themselves that they might refresh their soul. ([Lamentations 1:19](#))
- So then, Peter was in his prison cell, but **intense** prayer was being carried on for him, by all in the congregation of anointed Christians in Jerusalem.
- Consequently Peter was being kept in the prison, but prayer to God for him was being carried on **intensely** by the congregation. ([Acts of Apostles 12:5](#))
- So by now, both Silas and Timothy had arrived from Macedonia, and so Paul began to be **intensely** occupied with the preaching of the word of God. He thus witnessed to the Jews, that Jesus is the Messiah of God, proving this thoroughly through scriptural references.
- When, now, both Silas and Timothy came down from Macedonia, Paul began to be **intensely** occupied with the word, witnessing to the Jews to prove that Jesus is the Christ. ([Acts of Apostles 18:5](#))
- Paul then showed, that as a Jew, his nation, all twelve tribes, were hoping to attain to the fulfillment of these very promises of Yehowah God, through the act of **intensely** rendering him sacred service night and day. Then Paul showed, that it was concerning this hope, that he was standing there accused by the Jews.
- Whereas our twelve tribes are hoping to attain to the fulfillment of this promise by **intensely** rendering him sacred service night and day. Concerning this hope I am accused by Jews, O king. ([Acts of Apostles 26:7](#))
- Peter now encourages them, that now that they have purified their souls by applying the truth in their lives through their heartfelt

obedience to God's Holy Spirit, which has resulted in a true and unhyprocritical brotherly affection for one another, that they should now love one another **intensely** from the heart, for they are going to spend eternity together in their joint service to God in heaven.

- Now that you have purified your souls by your obedience to the truth with unhyprocritical brotherly affection as the result, love one another **intensely** from the heart. (**1 Peter 1:22**)
- Nonetheless, despite the telling in advance by thousands of years about this coming day of judgment with all mankind in writing through the Bible record, that day of accounting will still come as a thief upon the human family. They will not see it coming, but will only realize its presence after the fact, just as the visit of a thief is only realized after the fact, by observing the things that are now missing.
- Then the heavens that are now will pass away with a hissing noise as the gasses in the atmosphere are suddenly released, and the elements of the earth will melt, because of being **intensely** hot, and will be dissolved. Also the earth and all the hidden works in it will be discovered.
- These things have symbolic meaning primarily, for the heavens that are now are the wicked demonic rulers of the spiritual darkness we live in today, Satan the Devil and his demons. And the old earth which is governed over by wicked human rulers under Satan the Devil's control through the governments of men will come under the intense heat of Yehowah's inspection and will melt away to their eternal destruction.
- Likewise the works they worked to maintain, their rulership of the old earth, will be discovered, and their deceptions and their oppressions of mankind will be shown up and will end for all time.
- Also the elemental parts of Satan the Devil's system of things, the governments, false religion, commerce and the military will be dissolved away, and mankind will be set free of their wicked dominion. Praise Yehowah!
- Yet Yehowah's day will come as a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a hissing noise, but the elements being **intensely** hot will be dissolved, and earth and the works in it will be discovered. (**2 Peter 3:10**)

- Every day that an anointed Christian lives, should be lived with these things kept closely in mind. For when the time comes for that day to manifest itself, these symbolic heavens being on fire will be dissolved, and the elemental parts of Satan the Devil's system of things will melt down from the **intense** heat of Yehowah God's scrutiny upon them.
- Awaiting and keeping close in mind the presence of the day of Yehowah, through which the heavens being on fire will be dissolved and the elements being **intensely** hot will melt! (2 Peter 3:12)
