

### ~INTENSE (34)

[English, strong, powerful, forceful, concentrated, deep, passionate, extreme, severe, Opposite of, moderate]

- The Psalmist speaking prophetically about the Messiah said that it was not an enemy who had reproached him or an **intense** hater of him that had assumed airs against him.
- For it was not an enemy that proceeded to reproach me, otherwise I could put up with it. It was not an **intense** hater of me that assumed great airs against me, otherwise I could conceal myself from him. (Psalms 55:12)
- Yehowah asks through Jeremiah have I become a wilderness, a place lacking water, or a land of **intense** darkness, without spiritual light?
- O generation, see for yourselves the word of Yehowah. Have I become a mere wilderness to Israel or a land of **intense** darkness? Why is it that these, my people, have said; We have roamed. We shall come to you no more? (Jeremiah 2:31)
- And one must say to him, What are these wounds on your person between your hands? And he will have to say; Those with which I was struck in the house of my **intense** lovers. (Zechariah 13:6)
- Paul counsels Christians to have **intense** love for one another, because this love will cover a multitude of sins.
- Above all things, have **intense** love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8)
