

## ~INTENSITY (26)

[English, strength, power, concentration, force, passion, amount, greatness, Opposite of, **moderation**]

- Jehoshaphat, due to a wound inflicted in a rapidly **intensifying** battle died in his chariot.
- And the battle kept rising in **intensity** on that day, and the king himself had to be kept in a standing position in the chariot facing the Syrians, and gradually he died in the evening, and the blood of the wound kept pouring out upon the interior of the war chariot. (**1 Kings 22:35**)
- And the battle kept rising in **intensity** on that day, and the king of Israel himself had to be kept in a standing position in the chariot facing the Syrians until the evening, and gradually he died at the time of the setting of the sun. (**2 Chronicles 18:34**)
- Paul proved with **intensity** publicly that the Jews were wrong.
- For with **intensity** he thoroughly proved the Jews to be wrong publicly, while he demonstrated by the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ. (**Acts of Apostles 18:28**)
