- Yehowah sees the hypocrisy of the intentions of those who say peace but whose intention is to sweep away both the well watered and the thirsty ones.
- And it must occur that when someone has heard the words of this oath, and he has blessed himself in his heart, saying; I shall come to have peace, although I shall walk in the stubbornness of my heart, with the intention of sweeping away the well-watered one along with the thirsty ones. (Deuteronomy 29:19)
- Yehowah sees all those who are haughty in the intention of their hearts and will scatter them.
- He has performed mightily with his arm, he has scattered abroad those who are haughty in the intention of their hearts. (Luke 1:51)
- Paul followed through on his work with seriousness and honesty of commitment, with good intentions.
- Well, when I had such an intention, I did not indulge in any lightness, did I? Or what things I purpose, do I purpose them according to the flesh, that with me there should be Yes, Yes and No, No? (2 Corinthians 1:17)
