[English, examine, look into, explore, inspect, study, consider, probe, scrutinize]

- Yehowah counseled those judging in Israel to search and thoroughly **investigate** a matter to ascertain the truth.
- You must also search and **investigate** and inquire thoroughly, and if the thing is established as the truth, this detestable thing has been done in your midst. (**Deuteronomy 13:14**)
- The King **investigated** the matter Ezra brought to his attention and provided his support for a return to their homeland and rebuilding of the temple.
- Inasmuch as from before the king and his seven counselors an order was sent to **investigate** concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the Law of your God that is in your hand. (**Ezra 7:14**)
- When before the burning bush Moses marveled at the sight and then came closer to **investigate** it.
- Now when Moses saw it he marveled at the sight. But as he was approaching to **investigate**, Yehowah's voice came. (**Acts of Apostles 7:31**)
- Then God spoke to him from the bush and Moses did not dare to **investigate** it further.
- I am the God of your forefathers, the God of Abraham and of Isaac and of Jacob. Seized with trembling, Moses did not dare to **investigate** further. (**Acts of Apostles 7:32**)
