~IRA 1 (33) (I'ra) [Full-Grown Ass]

- A Jairite listed among King David's leading officers as, a priest of David.
- And Ira the Jairite also became a priest of David. (2 Samuel 20:26)
- Ira perhaps was a descendant of the Jair mentioned at;
- And Jair the son of Manasseh marched and went capturing their tent villages, and he began to call them Havvoth-jair. (Numbers 32:41)
- And therefore, in this case the designation priest may signify chief minister, prince. There is no Biblical evidence that the Jairites were Levites. However, if the reading of the Syriac Peshitta is correct, Ira may have been a priest from the Levite city of Jattir, Jathir.
- And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and the Pelethites. As for the sons of David, they became priests. (2 Samuel 8:18)
- And to the sons of Aaron they gave the cities of refuge, Hebron, and Libnah with its pasture grounds and Jattir and Eshtemoa with its pasture grounds. (1 Chronicles 6:57)
- And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and the Pelethites, and the sons of David were the first in position at the side of the king. (1 Chronicles 18:17)
