- The overseer should therefore be **irreprehensible**, a husband of one wife, moderate in habits, sound in mind, orderly, hospitable, qualified to teach. (**1 Timothy 3:2**)
- So keep on giving these commands, that they may be **irreprehensible**. (**1 Timothy 5:7**)
- All Christians should strive to be **irreprehensible**.
- That you observe the commandment in a spotless and **irreprehensible** way until the manifestation of our Lord Jesus Christ. (**1 Timothy 6:14**)
