- Paul counsels that overseers should be irreprehensible.
- The overseer should therefore be irreprehensible, a husband of one wife, moderate in habits, sound in mind, orderly, hospitable, qualified to teach. (1 Timothy 3:2)
- So keep on giving these commands, that they may be irreprehensible. (1 Timothy 5:7)
- All Christians should strive to be irreprehensible.
- That you observe the commandment in a spotless and irreprehensible way until the manifestation of our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Timothy 6:14)
