

**~ISHBAK (27)**  
**(Ish'bak)**

- The fifth listed of the six sons that Keturah bore to Abraham, which sons Abraham sent away with gifts, but without a share of his inheritance.
- Furthermore, Abraham again took a wife, and her name was Keturah. (**Genesis 25:1**)
- In time she bore him Zimran and Jokshan and Medan and Midian and **Ishbak** and Shuah. (**Genesis 25:2**)
- Later on Abraham gave everything he had to Isaac. (**Genesis 25:5**)
- But to the sons of the concubines that Abraham had Abraham gave gifts. Then he sent them away from Isaac his son, while he was still alive, eastward, to the land of the East. (**Genesis 25:6**)
- As for the sons of Keturah, Abraham's concubine, she gave birth to Zimran and Jokshan and Medan and Midian and **Ishbak** and Shuah. And the sons of Jokshan were Sheba and Dedan. (**1 Chronicles 1:32**)
