(Is'sa-char) [He Is Wages, that is, a man of wages]

- A Levite gatekeeper, seventh son of Korahite Obed-edom.

 Issachar, together with his relatives, was assigned to guard duty on the South side of the sanctuary in Jerusalem.
- For the divisions of gatekeepers. Of the Korahites, Meshelemiah the son of Kore of the sons of Asaph. (1 Chronicles 26:1)
- And Meshelemiah had sons, Zechariah the firstborn, Jediael the second, Zebadiah the third, Jathniel the fourth. (1 Chronicles 26:2)
- Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Elieho-enai the seventh. (1 Chronicles 26:3)
- And Obed-edom had sons. Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third and Sacar the fourth and Nethanel the fifth. (1 Chronicles 26:4)
- Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peullethai the eighth, for God had blessed him. (1 Chronicles 26:5)
- So they cast lots for the small the same as for the great by their paternal houses, for the different gates. (1 Chronicles 26:13)
- Obed-edom had his to the south, and his sons had the storehouses. (1 Chronicles 26:15)
