

~JABESH 1 (27)

(Ja'besh) [possibly, Dried-Up Place]

- A town in the northern section of Gilead. Also known as **Jabesh-gilead**, it is mentioned in the history of the judges and kings.
- And they went on to say; Which one out of the tribes of Israel is it that has not come up to Yehowah at Mizpah? And, look! No one had come into the camp from **Jabesh-gilead** to the congregation. (**Judges 21:8**)
- And Nahash the Ammonite proceeded to go up and camp against **Jabesh** in **Gilead**. At that all the men of Jabesh said to Nahash; Conclude a covenant with us that we may serve you. (**1 Samuel 11:1**)
- And all those of **Jabesh** in **Gilead** got to hear of all that the Philistines had done to Saul. (**1 Chronicles 10:11**)
- So all the valiant men rose up and carried off the corpse of Saul and the corpses of his sons and brought them to **Jabesh** and buried their bones under the big tree in Jabesh, and they went fasting for seven days. (**1 Chronicles 10:12**)
