## ~JAIR 2 (21) (Ja'ir)

- The seventh judge of Israel. Since he was a Gileadite of high standing and each of his 30 sons is connected with one of the abovementioned tent cities of Jair, he was likely a descendant of JAIR 1 above. Jair judged Israel for 22 years, after which he died and was buried in Kamon.
- Then after him Jair the Gileadite rose up, and he continued to judge Israel for twenty-two years. (Judges 10:3)
- And he came to have thirty sons who rode on thirty full-grown asses, and they had thirty cities. These they continue to call Havvoth-jair down to this day, they are in the land of Gilead. (Judges 10:4)
- After that Jair died and was buried in Kamon. (Judges 10:5)
