## ~JAPHLETITES (23) (Japh'le-tites) [Of, or belonging to, Japhlet]

- An ancient people occupying territory on Ephraim's boundary when the Israelites moved into the Promised Land.
- And it went down westward to the boundary of the Japhletites as far as the boundary of Lower Beth-horon and Gezer, and its termination proved to be at the sea. (Joshua 16:3)
- There is no historical evidence linking the Japhletites with the descendant of Asher who was named Japhlet.
- The sons of Asher were Imnah and Ishvah and Ishvi and Beriah, and Serah was their sister. (1 Chronicles 7:30)
- As for Heber, he became father to Japhlet and Shomer and Hotham, and to Shua their sister. (1 Chronicles 7:32)
- Secular history provides no additional information about them.
