## ~JECOLIAH (23)

(Je-co-li'ah) [Yehowah Has Been Able]

- Mother of Judah's King Uzziah, Azariah, whom she bore in about 845 B.C.E. Jecoliah, wife of Amaziah, was from Jerusalem.
- In the twenty-seventh year of Jeroboam the king of Israel,
  Azariah the son of Amaziah the king of Judah became king. (2
  Kings 15:1)
- Sixteen years old he happened to be when he began to reign, and for fifty-two years he reigned in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jecoliah of Jerusalem. (2 Kings 15:2)
- Then all the people of Judah took Uzziah, he being sixteen years old, and they made him king in place of his father Amaziah. (2 Chronicles 26:1)
- Sixteen years old was Uzziah when he began to reign, and for fifty-two years he reigned in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jecoliah of Jerusalem. (2 Chronicles 26:3)
