~JEDAIAH 6,7 (37) (Je-da'iah)[3-8, Hebrew, Yedha'-yah', Yah Knows]

- Two priests of this name are included in the list of those who returned with Jeshua and Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.
- And these were the priests and the Levites that went up with Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and Jeshua, Seraiah, Jeremiah, Ezra. (Nehemiah 12:1)
- Shemaiah, and Joiarib, Jedaiah. (Nehemiah 12:6)
- Sallu, Amok, Hilkiah, Jedaiah. These were the heads of the priests and their brothers in the days of Jeshua. (Nehemiah 12:7)
- During the priesthood of Jeshua's successor Joiakim, each of the two is referred to as a paternal house, one represented by Uzzi and the other by Nethanel.
- And in the days of Joiakim there happened to be priests, the heads of the paternal houses: for Seraiah, Meraiah, for Jeremiah, Hananiah. (Nehemiah 12:12)
- And for Joiarib, Mattenai, for Jedaiah, Uzzi. (Nehemiah 12:19)
- For Hilkiah, Hashabiah, for Jedaiah, Nethanel. (Nehemiah 12:21)
- Whether either or both of these Jedaiah's are connected with the original paternal house.
