## ~JEHIELI (36) (Je-hi'e-li) [Of, or belonging to, Jehiel]

- A Gershonite Levite who apparently served as an overseer of the sanctuary's treasury.
- As regards the Levites, Ahijah was over the treasures of the house of the true God and over the treasures of the things made holy. (1 Chronicles 26:20)
- The sons of Ladan, the sons of the Gershonite belonging to Ladan, the heads of the paternal houses belonging to Ladan the Gershonite, Jehieli. (1 Chronicles 26:21)
- The sons of Jehieli, Zetham and Joel his brother, were over the treasures of the house of Yehowah. (1 Chronicles 26:22)
- He is elsewhere called, Jehiel.
- Then David distributed them in divisions to the sons of Levi, to Gershon, Kohath and Merari. (1 Chronicles 23:6)
- To the Gershonites, Ladan and Shimei. (1 Chronicles 23:7)
- The sons of Ladan were Jehiel the headman and Zetham and Joel, three. (1 Chronicles 23:8)
- And what stones were found with any persons they gave to the treasure of the house of Yehowah under the control of Jehiel the Gershonite. (1 Chronicles 29:8)
