## ~JEHIEL 9 (27) (Je-hi'el) [May He Live, O God]

- One whose son acknowledged to Ezra the great error of the people in taking foreign wives, descendant of Elam.
- Then Shecaniah the son of Jehiel of the sons of Elam answered and said to Ezra; We, we have acted unfaithfully against our God, so that we gave a dwelling to foreign wives from the peoples of the land. Yet now there exists a hope for Israel concerning this. (Ezra 10:2)
- The Jehiel at;
- And of the sons of Elam, Mattaniah, Zechariah and Jehiel and Abdi and Jeremoth and Elijah. (Ezra 10:26)
- Included in the list of those who sent away their foreign wives and sons.
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
- Is possibly the same person, or at least another descendant of Elam.
