~JEHOSHUA (31) (Je-hosh'u-a) [Yehowah Is Salvation]

- Son of Nun, an Ephraimite who succeeded Moses and led the Israelites into the Promised Land. His original name was Hoshea, but Moses called him Jehoshua, or Joshua, a short form of Jehoshua.
- Of the tribe of Ephraim, Hoshea the son of Nun. (Numbers 13:8)
- These are the names of the men whom Moses sent to spy out the land. And Moses continued to call Hoshea the son of Nun Jehoshua. (Numbers 13:16)
- And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hand upon him, and the sons of Israel began to listen to him and they went doing just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. (Deuteronomy 34:9)
- And it came about after the death of Moses the servant of Yehowah that Yehowah proceeded to say to Joshua the son of Nun, the minister of Moses. (Joshua 1:1)
- Moses my servant is dead. Now get up, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel. (Joshua 1:2)
