~JEKAMEAM (29)

(Jek-a-me'am) [May the People Rise Up]

- The fourth son of Hebron, a Kohathite Levite, and founder of a Levitical paternal house that survived at least until David's reign.
- The sons of Kohath were Amram, Izhar, Hebron and Uzziel, four. (1 Chronicles 23:12)
- The sons of Hebron were Jeriah the head, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third and Jekameam the fourth. (1 Chronicles 23:19)
- And the sons of Hebron, Jeriah the head, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, Jekameam the fourth. (1 Chronicles 24:23)
- And the sons of Mushi were Mahli and Eder and Jerimoth. These were the sons of the Levites by their paternal houses. (1 Chronicles 24:30)
- And they themselves also proceeded to cast lots exactly as their brothers the sons of Aaron did before David the king and Zadok and Ahimelech and the heads of the paternal houses of the priests and of the Levites. As respects paternal houses, the head one was exactly as his younger brother. (1 Chronicles 24:31)
