(Je-rah'me-el) [May God Show Mercy, God Has Shown Mercy]

- The firstborn of Judah's grandson Hezron. The royal and Messianic lineage passed through Jerahmeel's brother Ram, apparently the same as Arni. An extensive genealogy is included for Jerahmeel's descendants, some of whom inhabited the southern part of Judah.
- And Tamar his daughter-in-law it was that bore to him Perez and Zerah. All the sons of Judah were five. (1 Chronicles 2:4)
- The sons of Perez were Hezron and Hamul. (1 Chronicles 2:5)
- And the sons of Hezron that were born to him were Jerahmeel and Ram and Chelubai. (1 Chronicles 2:9)
- As for Ram, he became father to Amminadab. Amminadab, in turn, became father to Nahshon the chieftain of the sons of Judah. (1 Chronicles 2:10)
- Nahshon, in turn, became father to Salma. Salma, in turn, became father to Boaz. (1 Chronicles 2:11)
- Boaz, in turn, became father to Obed. Obed, in turn, became father to Jesse. (1 Chronicles 2:12)
- Jesse, in turn, became father to his firstborn Eliab, and Abinadab the second, and Shimea the third. (1 Chronicles 2:13)
- Nethanel the fourth, Raddai the fifth. (1 Chronicles 2:14)
- Ozem the sixth, David the seventh. (1 Chronicles 2:15)
- And the sons of Jerahmeel the firstborn of Hezron were Ram the firstborn and Bunah and Oren and Ozem, Ahijah. (1 Chronicles 2:25)
- And Jerahmeel came to have another wife, whose name was Atarah. She was the mother of Onam. (1 Chronicles 2:26)
- And the sons of Ram the firstborn of Jerahmeel came to be Maaz and Jamin and Eker. (1 Chronicles 2:27)

- And the sons of Onam came to be Shammai and Jada. And the sons of Shammai were Nadab and Abishur. (1 Chronicles 2:28)
- And the name of Abishur's wife was Abihail, who in time bore him Ahban and Molid. (1 Chronicles 2:29)
- And the sons of Nadab were Seled and Appaim. But Seled died without sons. (1 Chronicles 2:30)
- And the sons of Appaim were Ishi. And the sons of Ishi were Sheshan, and the sons of Sheshan, Ahlai. (1 Chronicles 2:31)
- And the sons of Jada the brother of Shammai were Jether and Jonathan. But Jether died without sons. (1 Chronicles 2:32)
- And the sons of Jonathan were Peleth and Zaza. These became the sons of Jerahmeel. (1 Chronicles 2:33)
- And Sheshan came to have no sons, but daughters. Now Sheshan had an Egyptian servant whose name was Jarha. (1 Chronicles 2:34)
- So Sheshan gave his daughter to Jarha his servant as a wife, who in time bore him Attai. (1 Chronicles 2:35)
- Attai, in turn, became father to Nathan. Nathan, in turn, became father to Zabad. (1 Chronicles 2:36)
- Zabad, in turn, became father to Ephlal. Ephlal, in turn, became father to Obed. (1 Chronicles 2:37)
- Obed, in turn, became father to Jehu. Jehu, in turn, became father to Azariah. (1 Chronicles 2:38)
- Azariah, in turn, became father to Helez. Helez, in turn, became father to Eleasah. (1 Chronicles 2:39)
- Eleasah, in turn, became father to Sismai. Sismai, in turn, became father to Shallum. (1 Chronicles 2:40)
- Shallum, in turn, became father to Jekamiah. Jekamiah, in turn, became father to Elishama. (1 Chronicles 2:41)

- And the sons of Caleb the brother of Jerahmeel were Mesha his firstborn, who was the father of Ziph, and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron. (1 Chronicles 2:42)
- Then Achish said; Where did you men make a raid today? To this David said; Upon the south of Judah and upon the south of the Jerahmeelites and upon the south of the Kenites. (1 Samuel 27:10)
- Son of Amminadab, son of Arni, son of Hezron, son of Perez, son of Judah. (Luke 3:33)
