~JEREMAI (17)

(Jer'e-mai) [shortened form of Jeremoth or of Jeremiah]

- A postexilic Israelite, one of the seven sons or descendants of Hashum who had taken foreign wives but sent them away.
- And of Israel, of the sons of Parosh there were Ramiah and Izziah and Malchijah and Mijamin and Eleazar and Malchijah and Benaiah. (Ezra 10:25)
- Of the sons of Hashum, Mattenai, Mattattah, Zabad, Eliphelet, Jeremai, Manasseh and Shimei. (Ezra 10:33)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
