(Jer-e-mi'ah) [possibly, Yehowah Exalts, or, Yehowah Loosens, likely from the womb]

- A priest, or one representing a household by that name, among those attesting by seal the trustworthy arrangement entered into before Yehowah by Nehemiah and the princes, priests, and Levites, to walk in God's Law.
- If the name stands for a house rather than an individual, this may be the same as;

- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- Seraiah, Azariah, Jeremiah. (Nehemiah 10:2)
- They were adhering to their brothers, their majestic ones, and coming into liability to a curse and into an oath, to walk in the Law of the true God, which had been given by the hand of Moses the servant of the true God, and to keep and to perform all the commandments of Yehowah our Lord and his judicial decisions and his regulations. (Nehemiah 10:29)
