(Jer'e-moth) [from a root meaning, be high, exalted]

- Three Israelites, of the sons of Elam, Zattu, and Bani respectively, who sent away their foreign wives and sons in Ezra's day.
- And of Israel, of the sons of Parosh there were Ramiah and Izziah and Malchijah and Mijamin and Eleazar and Malchijah and Benaiah. (Ezra 10:25)
- And of the sons of Elam, Mattaniah, Zechariah and Jehiel and Abdi and Jeremoth and Elijah. (Ezra 10:26)
- And of the sons of Zattu, Elioenai, Eliashib, Mattaniah and Jeremoth and Zabad and Aziza. (Ezra 10:27)
- And of the sons of Bani, Meshullam, Malluch and Adaiah, Jashub and Sheal and Jeremoth. (Ezra 10:29)
- These all had accepted foreign wives, and they proceeded to send away wives along with sons. (Ezra 10:44)
