~JESHIMON 2 (29) (Je-shi'mon) [Desert]

- A region near Ziph, situated North of the Wilderness of Maon. It would appear that Jeshimon included part of the Wilderness of Judah and lay a few miles Southeast of Hebron. In this area of naked, chalky hills, David and his men hid from King Saul.
- Later the men of Ziph went up to Saul at Gibeah, saying; Is not David concealing himself close by us in the places difficult to approach at Horesh, on the hill of Hachilah, which is to the right side of Jeshimon? (1 Samuel 23:19)
- So they rose up and went to Ziph ahead of Saul, while David and his men were in the wilderness of Maon in the Arabah to the south of Jeshimon. (1 Samuel 23:24)
- In time the men of Ziph came to Saul at Gibeah, saying; Is not David concealing himself on the hill of Hachilah, facing Jeshimon? (1 Samuel 26:1)
- And Saul took up camping on the hill of Hachilah, which faces Jeshimon, by the road, while David was dwelling in the wilderness. And he got to see that Saul had come after him into the wilderness. (1 Samuel 26:3)
