

## ~JESHUA 8 (28)

(Jesh'u-a) [possibly a shortened form of Jehoshua, meaning, Yehowah Is Salvation]

- A town in the southern part of Judah where some of the repatriated Jewish remnant dwelt. Its site is identified by some scholars as **Tell es-Sa`weh**, **Tel Yeshu`a**, about 15 kilometers (9 miles) East-Northeast of Beer-sheba.
- And as regards the settlements in their fields, there were some of the sons of Judah that dwelt in Kiriath-arba and its dependent towns and in Dibon and its dependent towns and in Jekabzeel and its settlements. (**Nehemiah 11:25**)
