(Jesh'u-a) [possibly a shortened form of Jehoshua, meaning, Yehowah Is Salvation]

- A town in the southern part of Judah where some of the repatriated Jewish remnant dwelt. Its site is identified by some scholars as Tell es-Sa`weh, Tel Yeshu`a, about 15 kilometers (9 miles) East-Northeast of Beer-sheba.
- And as regards the settlements in their fields, there were some of the sons of Judah that dwelt in Kiriath-arba and its dependent towns and in Dibon and its dependent towns and in Jekabzeel and its settlements. (Nehemiah 11:25)
- And in Jeshua and in Moladah and in Beth-pelet. (Nehemiah 11:26)
- It may be the Shema of;
- Amam and Shema and Moladah. (Joshua 15:26)

- And they came to have in their inheritance Beer-sheba with Sheba, and Moladah. (Joshua 19:2)
