~JEZREEL 3 (26) (Jez're-el) [God Will Sow Seed, Jezreelite, Jez're-el-ite]

- An unidentified city in the mountainous region of Judah, perhaps founded by JEZREEL 1.
- This was the inheritance of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families. (Joshua 15:20)
- And in the mountainous region Shamir and Jattir and Socoh. (Joshua 15:48)
- And Jezreel and Jokdeam and Zanoah. (Joshua 15:56)
- This Jezreel doubtless was the home of David's wife Ahinoam.
- David had also taken Ahinoam from Jezreel, and the women came to be, even both of them, his wives. (1 Samuel 25:43)
- And David continued to dwell with Achish in Gath, he and his men, each one with his household, David and his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess and Abigail, Nabal's wife, the Carmelitess. (1 Samuel 27:3)
