## ~JOAB 1 (22) (Jo'ab) [Yehowah Is Father]

- Son of Seraiah, a descendant of Kenaz of the tribe of Judah. Joab was the father of Ge-harashim, meaning, Valley of Craftsmen, for, says the Bible account, craftsmen are what they became. Evidently Joab was father or founder of the community of craftsmen living in the valley.
- The sons of Judah were Perez, Hezron and Carmi and Hur and Shobal. (1 Chronicles 4:1)
- And the sons of Kenaz were Othniel and Seraiah, and the sons of Othniel, Hathath. (1 Chronicles 4:13)
- As for Meonothai, he became father to Ophrah. As for Seraiah, he became father to Joab the father of Ge-harashim, for craftsmen are what they became. (1 Chronicles 4:14)
