## ~JOASH 6 (30) (Jo'ash)

- One of those into whose custody the faithful prophet Micaiah was committed for imprisonment by Ahab. He is designated the king's son.
- Then the king of Israel said; Take Micaiah and turn him back to Amon the chief of the city and to Joash the king's son. (1 Kings 22:26)
- And you must say; This is what the king has said; Put this fellow in the house of detention and feed him with a reduced allowance of bread and a reduced allowance of water until I come in peace. (1 Kings 22:27)
- Then the king of Israel said; Take Micaiah and turn him back to Amon the chief of the city and to Joash the king's son. (2 Chronicles 18:25)
- And you men must say; This is what the king has said; Put this fellow in the house of detention and feed him with a reduced allowance of bread and a reduced allowance of water until I return in peace. (2 Chronicles 18:26)
- This expression may refer to an offspring of King Ahab or it could denote an official of royal descent or someone else closely connected with the royal household.
