## ~JOBAB 2 (33) (Jo'bab)

- Son of Zerah from Bozrah, an Edomite monarch who reigned sometime before Saul ruled as Israel's first king. Jobab succeeded Bela the son of Beor to the throne.
- Now these are the kings who reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel. (Genesis 36:31)
- And Bela son of Beor proceeded to reign in Edom, and the name of his city was Dinhabah. (Genesis 36:32)
- When Bela died, Jobab son of Zerah from Bozrah began to reign instead of him.
  (Genesis 36:33)
- When Jobab died, Husham from the land of the Temanites began to reign instead of him. (Genesis 36:34)
- And these are the kings that reigned in the land of Edom before any king reigned over the sons of Israel, Bela the son of Beor, the name of whose city was Dinhabah. (1 Chronicles 1:43)
- Eventually Bela died, and Jobab the son of Zerah from Bozrah began to reign in place of him. (1 Chronicles 1:44)
- Eventually Jobab died, and Husham from the land of the Temanites began to reign in place of him. (1 Chronicles 1:45)
