[English equivalent of Jehohanan, meaning, Yehowah Has Shown Favor, Yehowah Has Been Gracious]

- **Father of the apostle Simon Peter.**
- He led him to Jesus. When Jesus looked upon him he said; You are Simon the son of John; You will be called Cephas, which is translated Peter. (John 1:42)
- When, now, they had breakfasted, Jesus said to Simon Peter; Simon son of John, do you love me more than these? He said to him; Yes, Lord, you know I have affection for you. He said to him; Feed my lambs. (John 21:15)
- Again he said to him, a second time; Simon son of John, do you love me? He said to him; Yes, Lord, you know I have affection for you. He said to him; Shepherd my little sheep. (John 21:16)
- He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you have affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the third time; Do you have affection for me? So he said to him; Lord, you know all things; You are aware that I have affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (John 21:17)
- He is called John, according to the Sinaitic Manuscript and the Old Latin versions. Some manuscripts and versions call him Jona.
 Jesus calls him Jonah at;
- In response Jesus said to him; Happy you are, Simon son of Jonah, because flesh and blood did not reveal it to you, but my Father who is in the heavens did. (Matthew 16:17)
