## ~JOINING (100)

[English, amalgamation, union, combination, fusion, unification, Opposite of, separation]

- The shoulder pieces of the ephod had a joining together in the front.
- And you must make two rings of gold and put them upon the two shoulder pieces of the ephod from below, on its forefront, near its place of joining, above the girdle of the ephod. (Exodus 28:27)
- Then they made two rings of gold and put them upon the two shoulder pieces of the ephod from below, on its forefront, near its place of joining, above the girdle of the ephod. (Exodus 39:20)
- Gold hooks were joining together the separate pieces of tent cloth to make the tabernacle.
- After that he made fifty hooks of copper for joining the tent together to become one piece. (Exodus 36:18)
- The Jews enjoined upon themselves and their offspring the keeping of the two days of Purim throughout their generations.
- The Jews imposed and accepted upon themselves and upon their offspring and upon all those joining themselves to them, that it should not pass away, the obligation to be regularly holding these two days according to what was written concerning them and according to their appointed time in each and every year. (Esther 9:27)
- Their Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses have joined house to house and annexed field to field, by saying that only their understanding of the Bible matters, and that all others must not be listened to, for they declare all others are apostates, without even hearing what they have to say.
- They then tell all of their members to listen to no other understanding except what comes out of their mouths. They thus left no avenue for truth to flow, and so they have been rejected, for they rejected truth, and the Son of Man.

- Woe to the ones joining house to house, and those who annex field to field until there is no more room and you men have been made to dwell all by yourselves in the midst of the land! (Isaiah 5:8)
- The wings joining one to another indicates that all of God's creations work or cooperate together. The fact that they would not turn when they went indicated that, they would not deviate from Yehowah's plan as outlined in the Bible. They would go straight in the doing of God's will. They must not deviate or take a self-willed course.
- Their wings were joining one to the other. They would not turn when they went, they would go each one straight forward. (Ezekiel 1:9)
- Their wings spreading up outwards in the open position denotes their readiness to do God's will. The two wings joining each other indicate that these qualities are never expressed individually. Rather they work jointly to maintain balance in life. The two that were covering indicate that man must live within the bounds of doing God's will which will keep him balanced in the expression of these four primary qualities.
- That is the way their faces were. And their wings were spreading out upward. Each one had two joining to each other, and two were covering their bodies. (Ezekiel 1:11)
- Inside of the Most Holy was a table on top of which was the Ark of the Covenant with its cover of pure gold on top of which stood the cherubs with their wings outstretched. The Ark was made of Achaia wood and was covered with gold all over. The organic wood represented how man's imperfection would be covered over by Yehowah's pure love toward all of those in the New Covenant.
- And I saw that there was a high platform for the house all around. As regards the foundations of the side chambers, there was a full reed of six cubits to the joining. (Ezekiel 41:8)
