- The pegs of the pillars supporting the tent of meeting was of silver, also their joints were.
- And its twenty pillars and their twenty socket pedestals are of copper. The pegs of the pillars and their joints are of silver. (Exodus 27:10)
- So, too, it is for the north side in length, the hangings being for a hundred cubits of length, and its twenty pillars and their twenty socket pedestals being of copper, the pegs of the pillars and their joints being of silver. (Exodus 27:11)
- And its five pillars and their pegs. And he overlaid their tops and their joints with gold, but their five socket pedestals were of copper. (Exodus 36:38)
- Their twenty pillars and their twenty socket pedestals were of copper. The pegs of the pillars and their joints were of silver. (Exodus 38:10)
- Also, for the north side there were a hundred cubits. Their twenty pillars and their twenty socket pedestals were of copper. The pegs of the pillars and their joints were of silver. (Exodus 38:11)
- But for the west side the hangings were for fifty cubits. Their pillars were ten and their socket pedestals ten. The pegs of the pillars and their joints were of silver. (Exodus 38:12)

- And their four pillars and their four socket pedestals were of copper. Their pegs were of silver and the overlaying of their heads and their joints were of silver. (Exodus 38:19)

- When Belshazzar first saw the writing upon the wall his hip joints were loosening and his knees were knocking in fear of this supernatural sight.
- At that time, as regards the king, his very complexion was changed in him, and his own thoughts began to frighten him, and his hip joints were loosening and his very knees were knocking each other. (Daniel 5:6)
- By our relationship to him, we were circumcised by the Holy Spirit, which cut away the resistance of our hearts to the doing of God's will, making us sensitive to the doing of God's will. Also this stripping off of our body of flesh, that surrounds the spirit being, that we really are inside, is the circumcision, that belongs to the Christ.
- Whereas he is not holding fast to the head, to the one from whom all the body, being supplied and harmoniously joined together by means of its joints and ligaments, goes on growing with the growth that God gives. (Colossians 2:19)
- Paul now shows anointed Christians, that the word of God is alive, and it exerts power in their lives, like the spirit, that formed this word. This word is written down for us in the form of the Bible today. This word is sharper than any two-edged sword, and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, between joints and their marrow.
- For the word of God is alive and exerts power and is sharper than any two-edged sword and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, and of joints and their marrow, and is able to discern thoughts and intentions of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)
