~JONATHAN 7 (20) (Jon'a-than) [Yehowah Has Given]

- A man of understanding, a secretary and a counselor for King David.
- And Jonathan, David's nephew, was a counselor, a man of understanding, he being also a secretary, and Jehiel the son of Hachmoni was with the king's sons. (1 Chronicles 27:32)
- In the Masoretic text Jonathan's relationship to David is indicated by the Hebrew word dohdh, which generally means, uncle. But in view of two references in the Scriptures to a nephew of David named Jonathan, it is likely that the word is here used in the wider sense of relative, here being brothers son or nephew. Ro, AS, Footnote, NW. He would thus be the same as.
