(Jon'a-than) [Yehowah Has Given]

- A man of understanding, a secretary and a counselor for King David.
- And **Jonathan**, David's nephew, was a counselor, a man of understanding, he being also a secretary, and Jehiel the son of Hachmoni was with the king's sons. (**1 Chronicles 27:32**)
- In the **Masoretic** text **Jonathan's** relationship to David is indicated by the **Hebrew** word *dohdh*, which generally means, **uncle**. But in view of two references in the Scriptures to a nephew of David named **Jonathan**, it is likely that the word is here used in the wider sense of relative, here being brothers son or nephew. **Ro, AS, Footnote, NW**. He would thus be the same as.
