~JOZABAD 2,3 (18)

(Jo'za-bad) [shortened form of Jehozabad, probably meaning, Yehowah Has Endowed]

- Two persons with this name were among the headmen of Manasseh who deserted to David when he was at Ziklag and became chiefs in his army.
- When he came to Ziklag there deserted to him from Manasseh Adnah and Jozabad and Jediael and Michael and Jozabad and Elihu and Zillethai, heads of the thousands that belonged to Manasseh. (1 Chronicles 12:20)
- And they, for their part, were of help to David against the marauder band, because all of them were mighty men of valor, and they came to be chiefs in the army. (1 Chronicles 12:21)
