~JUBAL (31) (Ju'bal) [possibly, Ram]

- Son of Lamech and Adah, descendant of Cain. As founder of all those who handle the harp and the pipe, Jubal may have invented both stringed and wind instruments, or perhaps he founded a profession, which gave considerable impetus to the progress of music.
- Afterward Cain had intercourse with his wife and she became pregnant and gave birth to Enoch. Then he engaged in building a city and called the city's name by the name of his son Enoch. (Genesis 4:17)
- Later there was born to Enoch Irad. And Irad became father to Mehujael, and Mehujael became father to Methushael, and Methushael became father to Lamech. (Genesis 4:18)
- And Lamech proceeded to take two wives for himself. The name of the first was Adah and the name of the second was Zillah. (Genesis 4:19)
- In time Adah gave birth to Jabal. He proved to be the founder of those who dwell in tents and have livestock. (Genesis 4:20)
- And the name of his brother was Jubal. He proved to be the founder of all those who handle the harp and the pipe. (Genesis 4:21)
